COMMONWEALTH FUND COLONIAL CIVIL SERVICE FELLOWSHIPS, 1954

With reference to Government Notice No. 1408 published in *Gazette* No. 58 of 8th October, 1953, it is understood from the Secretary of State that two Fellowships will again be offered in 1955 under conditions which are not expected to differ materially from those for 1954, *i.e.*

- (a) Candidates may be single or married; but they should not have attained the age of 40 on the 1st September of the year of award (1955);
- (b) Candidates should be sufficiently expert to carry out a definite scheme of advanced research work or study related to a problem exercising the candidate's Government and which can be investigated to special advantage in the United States. Officers with less than five years' service cannot be regarded as qualified for consideration;
- (c) Colonial Civil Service Fellowships are normally tenable for a minimum period of six months and a maximum period of twelve months. Fellows are normally expected to arrive in the United States in September of the year of award (1955);
- (d) Emoluments.—There is no fixed stipend; the emolument covers the full expenses of travel, residence and study during the Fellowship:—

- (i) The cost of the Fellow's travel (but not his wife's or child's) from his home to his principal base in the United States and return including \$500 for transatlantic passages;
- (ii) An allowance of \$950 for travel in the United States;
- (iii) A living allowance of \$12 a day during tenure of the Fellowship;
- (iv) Refund of any expenses (fees and the like) necessitated by the Fellow's enquiry and approved by the Fund;
 - (v) An equipment and book allowance of \$200.
- Further particulars together with application forms will be issued as soon as they are received from the Commonwealth Fund. It should be emphasised that only two Fellowships are available for the whole Colonial Empire and competition will, therefore, be very keen.
- 3. Meanwhile officers who wish to be considered are invited to submit their names to their Heads of Departments. Heads of Departments in turn are asked to consider carefully the claims of officers submitting applications and to forward to the Chief Secretary or appropriate Civil Secretary by the 1st of October, 1954 the name of not more than one officer from the Department concerned for preliminary consideration.
