### Magistrates' Courts Ordinance (Chapter 122)

### AUTHORITY FOR A MAGISTRATE TO EXERCISE INCREASED JURISDICTION

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor-General by section 23 (1) of the Magistrates' Courts Ordinance, Chapter 122 and on the recommendation of the Honourable the Chief Justice, I hereby authorise CLAUDE SOMERSET STYLE, Esquire, Magistrate Grade I, to exercise an increased jurisdiction in civil and criminal matters, as hereunder set out with effect from the date of the publication of this notice:—

In civil matters, increased jurisdiction under paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 19 (1) up to £500 in lieu of the maximum fine of £200 appearing in section 20.

In criminal matters, increased jurisdiction:—

(a) to impose up to a maximum fine of £500 in lieu of the maximum fine of £200 appearing in section 20.

(b) to order imprisonment up to a maximum period of imprisonment for five years in lieu of the present maximum period of imprisonment for two years appearing in the said section 20.

## MINIMUM PRODUCER PRICES AND MARKETING ARRANGEMENTS

It is notified for general information that the Northern Regional Marketing Board, by virtue of its powers under section 19 of the Northern Regional Marketing Board Law, (No. 7 of 1954) has made the following arrangements for the purchase of groundnuts through its licensed buying agents in the 1954-55 season in the Kano and Rivers Areas :

## OPENING OF THE SEASON

2. The opening dates of the 1954-55 Groundnut buying season are as follows :—

*Kano Area.*—Midnight 4th-5th November, 1954.

*Rivers Area.*—Midnight 18th-19th November, 1954.

The buying season will continue from these dates until dates in 1955 to be announced later.

## BUYING STATIONS

3. The buying stations under the 1954-55 Kano Area Groundnut Marketing Scheme and under the Rivers Area Groundnut Marketing Scheme are listed in the First and Second Schedules to this notice respectively.

## BUYING PRICES

4. (i) *Kano Area.*—Whereas in previous seasons buying station prices were based on a flat naked ex-scale railhead price the basic price in the 1954-55 season is a standard naked ex-scale port price of £45-14s-0d per ton ; this revised buying price structure being consequent upon the replacement of the flat rate railway tariff for groundnuts by a schedule of rail freight rates graduated in the main according to distance from port and designed to effect the most economic use of rolling stock. Since the basis of the producer price is a uniform port price, this necessarily means that the minimum buying station price at each individual railhead will vary with the amount of the rail freight rate. Prices at individual buying stations are determined by deducting from the basic port price, first the appropriate rail rate and also (in the case of buying stations away from the Railway) the cost of transporting groundnuts to railhead by approved routes, subject to the guarantee that the minimum buying price shall at no station fall below £28 per ton ; where the cost of evacuation would otherwise bring the buying station price below this figure, the price is maintained as in the previous season at £28 per ton by means of a subsidy payable by the Northern Regional Marketing Board.

The minimum buying station prices which are set out in Column 2 of the First Schedule to this notice reflect the arrangements described above. The prices so determined also give effect to the guarantee announced by the Nigeria Groundnut Marketing Board shortly after its Fourteenth Meeting on 30th March, 1954, that the naked ex-scale railway line buying station price for Kano Area groundnuts in the 1954-55 season would be not less than £36 per ton. At no railway line buying station is the 1954-55 season minimum producer price now announced less than this figure and at most stations increases over the previous year's minimum price are shown.

(ii) *Rivers Area.*—The naked ex-scale flat rate buying price will be £36 per ton at all gazetted buying stations in the Baro-Lokoja and Makurdi areas. The naked ex-scale flat rate buying price will be £35 per ton at gazetted buying stations in the Yola area with the exception of certain stations, as shown in the Second Schedule to this notice, where the price will be £34 per ton or £33 per ton according to distance from ocean port.

## PRODUCE SALES TAX

5. Under the provisions of the Produce Sales Tax Legislation, all sales of groundnuts made in the Northern Region to licensed buying agents of the Northern Regional Marketing Board are subject to Produce Sales Tax at the rate of £1 per ton.

6. For purposes of the collection of this tax for which the Northern Regional Marketing Board is accountable by law to the Northern Regional Treasury, the minimum prices payable by the licensed buying agents of the Board in respect of all purchases of groundnuts made in the Northern Region shall take the Produce Sales Tax into account and will accordingly be at the rates set out in Column 2 of the First Schedule to this notice in respect of the Kano Area and Column 2 of the Second Schedule to this notice in respect of the Rivers Area ; being the minimum buying station prices fixed by the Northern Regional Marketing Board reduced by the amount of Produce Sales Tax.
