4. *Minimum Buying Prices.*—The minimum buying price fixed by the Board is a naked ex-scale flat rate buying price of £20 per ton at all gazetted buying stations shown in the First Schedule to this notice.

5. *Produce Sales Tax.*—Under the provisions of Sale of Produce legislation all sales of Soy Beans made in the Northern Region to licensed buying agents of the Northern Regional Marketing Board are subject to Produce Sales Tax at the rate of 2s-6d per ton.

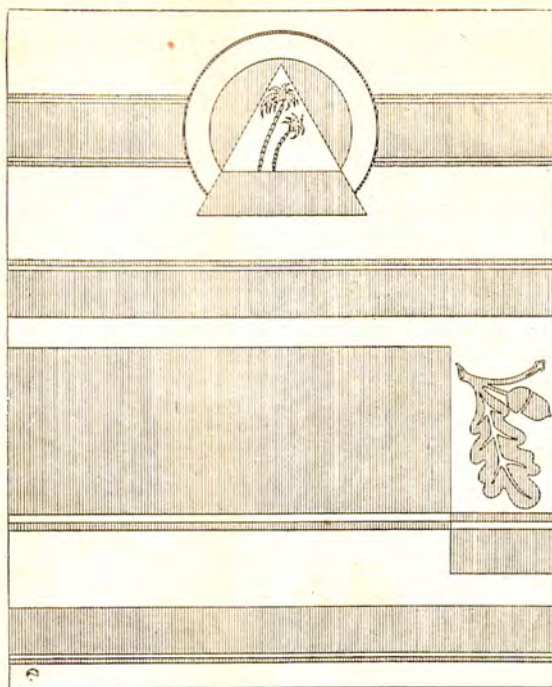

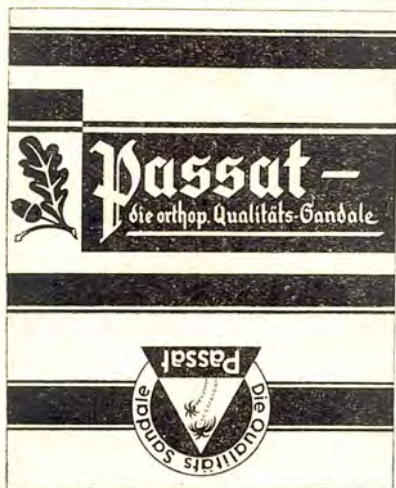

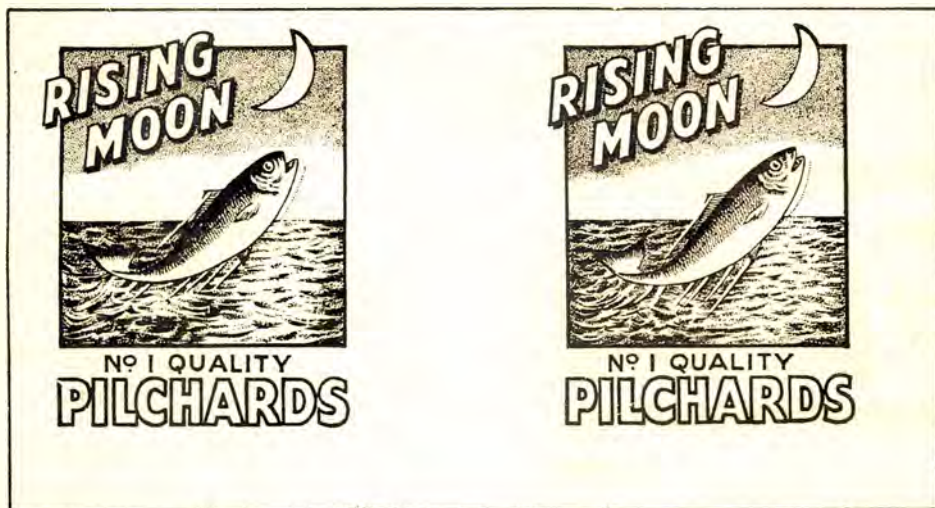
