## APPOINTMENT AS TEMPORARY MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

WHEREAS it is prescribed by section 92 of the Nigeria (Constitution) Order in Council, 1954, as amended, that whenever a Minister is absent from Nigeria the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Prime Minister, may, by Instrument under the Public Seal, appoint a person from amongst the members of the House of Representatives to be temporarily a member of the Council of Ministers.

AND WHEREAS on the 22nd day of September, 1958, the Honourable I. S. USMAN, M.H.R., was appointed to be temporarily a member of the Council of Ministers during the absence from Nigeria of Alhadji the Honourable Abubakar Tafawa Balewa, C.B.E., M.H.R.

AND WHEREAS the seat in the Council of Ministers of the Honourable I. S. USMAN, M.H.R., will become vacant on the return to Nigeria of Alhadji the Honourable Abubakar Tafawa Balewa, C.B.E., M.H.R., on the 29th day of October, 1958.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Honourable I. S. Usman, M.H.R., should continue as a temporary member of the Council of Ministers until the return to Nigeria of Alhadji the Honourable Muhammadu Ribadu, M.B.E., M.H.R.

NOW THEREFORE in pursuance of the provisions of the said section, I RALPH FRANCIS ALNWICK GREY, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Officer Administering the Government of the Federation of Nigeria, do hereby appoint with effect from the 29th day of October, 1958, the said Honourable I. S. USMAN, M.H.R., to be temporarily a member of the Council of Ministers during the absence from Nigeria of Alhadji the Honourable Muhammadu Ribadu, M.B.E., M.H.R., in the place of Chief the Honourable O. Oweh, M.H.R., and the Honourable D. C. Ugwu, M.H.R., whose appointments as temporary Ministers are hereby cancelled.
