3. It should be noted that the arrangements which have been made apply only to British nationals and not to citizens of other Commonwealth countries. In the Order, "British nationals" means:—

(a) citizens of the United Kingdom and Colonies, citizens of Rhodesia and Nyasaland, citizens of South Rhodesia, British subjects without citizenship, and British protected persons belonging to any of the territories for whose international relations the Government of the United Kingdom were on the 28th day of February, 1959, responsible and

(b) corporations and unincorporated associations constituted under the laws in force in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland or in any territory for whose international relations the Government of the United Kingdom were on the 28th day of February, 1959, responsible.
