AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FORTY-SIX MILLION, SIX HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Federation of Nigeria as follows—

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation (1960-61) Ordinance, 1960.

Short title.

Expenditure of £46,629,930 authorised out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. Schedule.

2. The Accountant-General of the Federation may, on the warrant of the Governor-General or the Minister of Finance, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation of Nigeria during the year ending on the 31st day of March, 1961, any sums not exceeding in the whole the sum of Forty-Six Million, Six Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty Pounds, being the total of the amounts set forth opposite Heads 21 to 64 in the Schedule.

Appropriation of £46,629,930. Schedule.

3. The said sum of Forty-Six Million, Six Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty Pounds, shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the manner expressed in the Schedule.

Balance unissued to lapse.

4. The moneys granted by this Ordinance are intended for the services in respect of which moneys will become payable within the year ending 31st day of March, 1961, and any balance thereof unissued at the end of the month of March of that year shall lapse and not be available for making payments in any subsequent month.
