THE ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
(CHAPTER 184)

— Road Traffic (Kumba-Mamfe) (Amendment) Order, 1960

Commencement : 1st December, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred upon a local authority by section 11 of the Road Traffic Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made by the District Officers of Kumba and Mamfe Divisions who have been specified as the persons to exercise such powers within their respective Divisions—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Kumba-Mamfe) (Amendment) Order, 1960, and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st December, 1960.

2. The Road Traffic (Kumba-Mamfe) Order, 1960, is hereby amended by deleting therefrom sections 4 and 5.

MINERALS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 121)

Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition (No. 4) Amendment
Declaration, 1960

Commencement : 29th December, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Minerals Ordinance, the Minister of Mines and Power of the Federation has made the following declaration :—

1. This declaration may be cited as the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Amendment (No. 4) Declaration, 1960.

Citation.

2. Immediately after paragraph 26 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1946, there shall be inserted the following new paragraphs :—

“27. The following area is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting for all minerals :—

All that parcel of land known as Mines Reclamation Area No. 25 (which is the South East Corner of ML.13931, formerly ML.673 and the South West Corner of ML.13932, formerly ML.674) in the Jos Division of Plateau Province, containing the area of approximately, 56.64 acres, the boundaries of which are described below.

Starting at a concrete pillar marked P.B.P 8411, the Colony Co-ordinates of which are N.2,065,892 feet E.2,348,773 feet, the boundaries run in straight lines, the bearings of which are as follows:—
