The duration of a first degree course is normally four years. Students possessing advanced entrance qualifications may be permitted to graduate in three years, if they show evidence of high academic ability.

*Entry requirements.*—Candidates for Honours or General degree courses in any Faculty or College must possess one or more of the following requirements:

(a) West African School Certificate, Division One or Two.

(b) General Certificate of Education at Ordinary level in six subjects passed at one and the same examination, including English Language and Mathematics (or an approved Science subject).

(c) Passes in two relevant subjects at Advanced level in the General Certificate of Education, provided the candidate has in addition three other subjects at Ordinary level. A candidate with passes in three relevant subjects at Advanced level would require only one other subject at Ordinary level; a candidate with passes in four or more subjects at Advanced level needs no additional passes at Ordinary level. The subjects need not be passed on one and the same occasion.

(d) Higher School Certificate, with passes at Principal standard in at least two relevant subjects (excluding General Paper).

(e) Post-Secondary qualifications beyond the levels of (a), (b), (c) and (d) above.

(f) Qualifications obtained from other countries and recognised by the University to be equivalent to (a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) above.

Candidates possessing any of these qualifications must not assume that they will automatically be offered admission to the University.

*Method of application.*—University Admission Forms will be supplied to all candidates who apply to the Deputy Registrar, University of Nigeria, Nsukka, Eastern Nigeria. Each candidate resident in Nigeria should enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope (size 9" x 4"); Admission Forms will not be sent to candidates resident in Nigeria who fail to comply with this requirement.

Completed Admission Forms must be returned to the Registrar, University of Nigeria, Nsukka on or before 29th April, 1961. Late entries will not be accepted. Candidates are strongly advised to draw the attention of persons who will complete the Confidential Section of their Admission Forms to this dateline.
