SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION BILL

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill makes supplementary provision for the service of the Federation for the year 1962-63, and provides for the repayment of advances made from the Contingencies Fund.

A BILL FOR

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE ISSUE OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND OF TWO MILLION, NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE POUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING ADVANCES FROM THE CONTINGENCIES FUND AND OF MAKING FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-THREE; AND TO APPROPRIATE THAT AMOUNT FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Federation of Nigeria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

- 5 1. The aggregate amount mentioned in section one of the Appropria-
tion Act, 1962 (which provides for the issue out of the Consolidated
Revenue Fund during the year ending on the 31st day of March, 1963,
of sums not exceeding in the aggregate £52,084,700) shall be increased
by two million, nine hundred and fifty-six thousand, six hundred and
seventy-one pounds; and the additional amount shall be appropriated—
- 10 (a) as to six hundred and seventy thousand, four hundred and
fifty-one pounds, to the replacement of advances from the Contingencies
Fund; and
- 15 (b) as to two million, two hundred and eighty-six thousand, two
hundred and twenty pounds, to heads of expenditure as indicated in
the Schedule to this Act;

and section three of that Act (which provides for the lapse of balances outstanding at the end of the financial year) shall have effect accordingly.

Short title
and extent.

2. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1962, and shall apply throughout the Federation.
