ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CAP. 184)

Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1962

*Commencement : 1st January, 1963*

WHEREAS the provision of subsection (3) of section five of the Road Traffic Act (which relates to the issue of vehicle licences expiring at the end of a calendar year or quarter) has been repealed and replaced by the Vehicle Licences Act, 1962.

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Road Traffic Act, the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Council of Ministers, has made the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1962, and shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1963.

(2) These regulations shall apply to and in respect of the Federal Territory of Lagos.

2. The Road Traffic Regulations are amended by the revocation of FORM F of the First Schedule thereof and the substitution therefor of the Form in the First Schedule hereto.

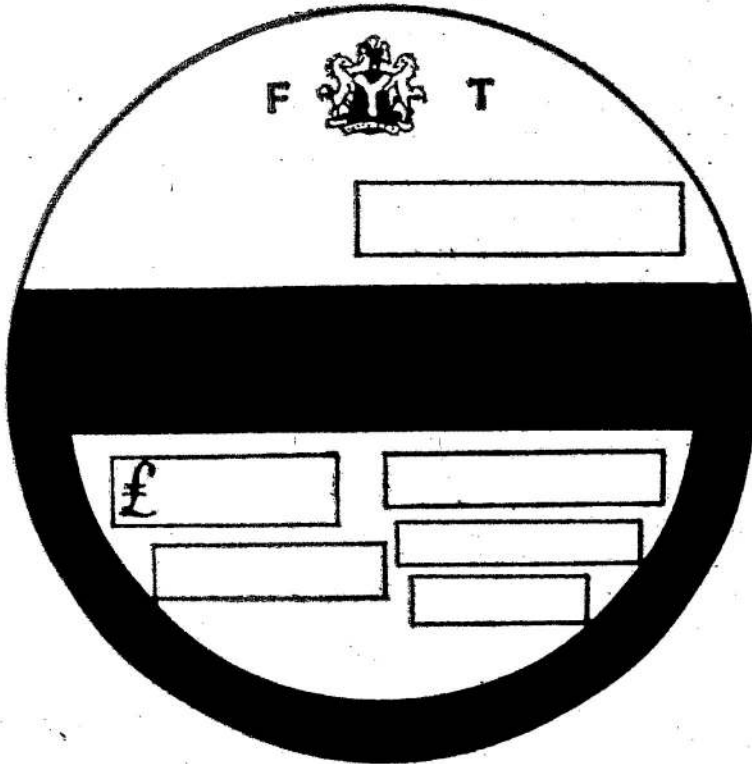
