Public Lands Acquisition Act (Chapter 167)

LAND REQUIRED FOR THE SERVICE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA

Notice is hereby given that all that parcel of land at Ekurede, Warri in the Warri Division, Delta Province, Mid-Western Nigeria, containing an area of approximately 210.2 acres the boundaries of which are described below is required by the President for public purposes absolutely and in particular for a National High School.

## DESCRIPTION

Starting at Peg 1 which lies on a bearing of 240° 03' and an approximate distance of 120.0 feet from a concrete pillar marked PBW4850 the co-ordinates of which are 4816.34' North and 5078.00' West of a concrete pillar marked IS the Origin of Warri Cadastral Surveys the boundaries run in straight lines the bearings and lengths of which are as follows :---
