Public Lands Acquisition Act (Chapter 167)

LAND REQUIRED FOR THE SERVICE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA

Notice is hereby given that all that parcel of land at Ekurede, Warri in the Warri Division, Delta Province, Mid-Western Nigeria, containing an area of approximately 210.2 acres the boundaries of which are described below is required by the President for public purposes absolutely and in particular for a National High School.

DESCRIPTION

Starting at Peg 1 which lies on a bearing of $240^{\circ} 03'$ and an approximate distance of 120.0 feet from a concrete pillar marked PBW4850 the co-ordinates of which are 4816.34' North and 5078.00' West of a concrete pillar marked IS the Origin of Warri Cadastral Surveys the boundaries run in straight lines the bearings and lengths of which are as follows:—

(The Starting Point)

All points and pegs are temporary. All bearings and lengths are approximate, and all bearings are referred to True North.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said land is required within six weeks from the date of this Notice to send to the Minister of Lagos Affairs care of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin-City, Mid-Western Nigeria, a statement of his right or interest and of the evidence therefore, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

- 3 The President is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said land,
4. Land in respect of which no statement is received is liable to be dealt with as unoccupied land.
5. And notice is also hereby given that the land is urgently required for public purposes and that the President intends to enter into possession of the said land on the day following the publication of this notice.
6. Any person who shall wilfully hinder or obstruct the President or any person employed by him from taking possession of the said lands is liable under the provisions of the Act above-mentioned on conviction to a fine of Twenty-five pounds or to imprisonment for three months.
