(ii) In the case of F.O.B. purchases from the NPMC—photostatic copies of the Contract of Sale made between them and the NPMC together with shipping documents showing that shipment will take place within this year.

3. The public are warned that applications not made in accordance with the conditions laid down in paragraph 2 above will not be considered under any circumstances.

2. The stores are lying at R.S.G. Ordnance Depot, Clifford Street, Yaba, Lagos and Ordnance Sub Depot, Kaduna, and may be inspected there between 0900 hours and 1300 hours from Monday 1st June, 1964 to Saturday 13th June, 1964.

3. The Tenders Board reserves the power of accepting contractors' tenders for lots as it may consider appropriate, unless the Contractors expressly stipulate to the contrary in the Tender forms.

4. All approved Contractors wishing to tender for these goods shall be required to place a deposit of £50 (fifty pounds) with the Paymaster, Pay & Records Office, Apapa, Lagos. This deposit will be refunded to unsuccessful contractors; but will be retained in respect of successful Contractors until the goods tendered for have been finally paid for, when the deposit will be refunded. If a successful Contractor, after seven days of notification of acceptance of his tender, defaults payments for the goods tendered for or in any way contravenes the conditions of sale, he will forfeit his deposit.

5. *Removal.*—The goods purchased must be removed from the Depot in which they are lying within three weeks of notification of clearance of cheque or payment. During the period from acceptance of tender and removal of goods responsibility will rest with the purchaser, although such provision as may be practicable for the guarding by the Military Authority will be retained. It will not be possible for the Military Authority to provide labour and transportation for the removal of the goods; goods shall be removed at the purchaser's expense.

6. Items purchased will NOT be sold or disposed of in Nigeria, and tenderers must indicate clearly where they intend to dispose of the goods when purchased.

7. *Other Conditions.*—(a) each tender form must show the amount proposed for the stores;

(b) if requested, arrangements can be made to bale clothing and to pack hats fezzes in wooden cases. An overall charge of £100 will be made or alternatively £10 per lot;

(c) successful tenderers will be notified of the total amount to be paid.
