NIGER DELTA SPECIAL AREA

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates of Niger Delta Special Area origin for scholarships to pursue University, Professional and Technological Courses.

- 2. Qualifications for Awards.—Candidates must be from the Niger Delta Special Area; that is both or one of the parents must belong to that Area by birth;
 - (a) No candidate will be considered who does not produce satisfactory evidence of this;
- (b) Candidates for University courses are expected to possess the necessary academic qualifications for direct entry to a University; that is, the usual pass in the appropriate subjects at the G.C.E. Advanced Level, H.S.C. at Principal Level or the equivalence of these. For the other courses, no candidate will be considered who does not possess at least a Grade II West African School Certificate with Credit in English and 4 other subjects relevant to the proposed course of study.
- 3. Applications.—Applications must be submitted by candidates of either sex who must be under 30 years of age by the 1st of January, 1965. Successful candidates will be required to pass a medical examination which should include an X-Ray and a tuberculin test.
