## CONSTITUTION OF MID-WESTERN NIGERIA ACT, 1964

## Constitution of Mid-Western Nigeria (Commencement) Order, 1964

Commencement: 10th January, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection (3) of section three of the Constitution of Mid-Western Nigeria Act, 1964, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order—

1. The Constitution of Mid-Western Nigeria Act, 1964, shall, unless as otherwise provided therein, come into force on the tenth day of January, 1964.

Commencement.

2. This Order may be cited as the Constitution of Mid-Western Nigeria (Commencement) Order, 1964.

Citation.

Made at Lagos this 10th day of January, 1964.
