PROCESSING OF IMPORT LICENCE APPLICATIONS FOR 1968

It is hereby notified that in order to facilitate the processing of import licence applications for 1968, importers in the respective States mentioned hereunder are advised to obtain the necessary application forms from the offices indicated against each State :

(i) *Importers in the Lagos State.*—From the Federal Ministry of Trade, Lagos.

(ii) *Importers in the Northern States.*—From the Federal Ministry of Trade at Kano and also from the offices of the Regional Ministry of Trade and Industry at Kaduna, Jos, Ilorin, Maiduguri, Makurdi, Yola, Zaria and Sokoto.

(iii) *Importers in the Western State.*—From the Federal Ministry of Trade at Ibadan and Ondo.

(iv) *Importers in the Mid-Western States.*—From the Federal Ministry of Trade, Sapele.

(v) *Importers in the Liberated Areas of the three Eastern States.*—From the Federal Ministry of Trade, Lagos.

2. Completed application forms should be returned to the offices from where they were obtained not later than 30th December, 1967. Late applications will not be entertained.

3. Recipients of licences during 1967 are requested to submit evidence of utilisation of such licences.

4. For information an import licence is required for any importation from the following Countries :—

- (a) Japan
- (b) Hong Kong, Macao and Colony
- (c) Communist China
- (d) East Germany
- (e) Roumania
- (f) North Korea
- (g) North Vietnam
- (h) Tibet and Albania.

Also, an import licence is required for importing the following goods from all Countries :—

Cement

Enamelware

Meat and Butter

Petroleum Products

Wheat Flour

Yarn

Stone, Sand and Gravel

Bicycle Tyres

Tyres for Passenger Cars and dual purpose vehicles

Bags and Sacks of Textile Materials (Hessian and Jute only)

Secondhand Clothing

Glass.—(a) Lamps Globes and Chimneys

(b) Jars for Cosmetics.
