Immigration (Control of Aliens) Regulations 1963
(L.N. 94 of 1963)

Immigration (Partial Exemption of Certain Aliens) Order 1968

Commencement : 7th March 1967

WHEREAS the Immigration (Control of Aliens) Regulations 1963 made under the authority of the Immigration Act 1963 prescribe sundry requirements to be complied with by aliens but empower the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs by order to exempt aliens from compliance therewith to any extent necessary, and it is expedient and in the public interest to exempt certain aliens :

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the power conferred upon him by regulation 23 of the regulations aforesaid and of all other powers (if any) him thereunto enabling, the Federal Commissioner aforesaid has made the following order :

1. Alien women married to Nigerian men are hereby exempt from compliance with the requirements of regulations 9 and 10 of the regulations aforesaid (which relate to notification of arrival and departure and to registration respectively).

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Partial Exemption of Certain Aliens) Order 1968 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 7th March 1967.

Citation etc.

(2) This order shall have effect throughout the Federation.
