DESCRIPTION

All that strip of land approximately 200 feet wide on the Ocean bottom, starting at the Meji Central Gathering Platform whose Colony Co-ordinates are N 158,750, E 302,000, and whose Geographic Co-ordinates are N 5° 26' 09", E 5° 08' 35", and extending on an approximate bearing of N 32° 09' 08" W

approximately 6.42 miles to a Point whose Colony Co-ordinates are N 167,500, E 296,500 and whose Geographic Co-ordinates are N 5° 30' 55", E 5° 05' 37" thence on an approximate bearing of N 8° 54' 33" E approximately 3.76 miles terminating at the Valve Platform whose Colony Co-ordinates are N 173,471, E 297,436 and whose Geographic Co-ordinates are N 5° 34' 09", E 5° 06' 06". The beginning of the line at Meji Central Gathering Platform will be in approximately 30 feet of water. The section of the line through the Escravos Ship Channel will be buried to a minimum depth of 25 feet below the dredged bottom of the channel. The termination of the line at the Valve Platform will be in approximately 15 feet of water.

2. A copy of the plan of the pipeline route identifying the sea bed and land affected can be inspected during all normal working hours at the Ministry of Works, Lands and Transport (Lands Division), Benin City; the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos, and the office at 19 Tinubu Square, Lagos, of the aforesaid Company.

3. Any person who considers that his interest or interests will be injuriously affected by the grant of the Licence should lodge orally or in writing, not less than seven days before the hearing date in Item 6, with the Ministry of Works, Lands and Transport (Lands Division), Benin City, notice of objection stating the interest of the objector and the grounds of objection.

4. Any Public Officer who receives a verbal objection in the course of his duties shall record the name and address, interest and grounds of objection of any person lodging such a verbal objection, and shall forward such details to the Ministry of Works, Lands and Transport (Lands Division), Benin City.

5. Matters relating to the amount of compensation payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of the sea bed and land affected shall not be material grounds to include in a notice of objection.

6. The Ministry of Works, Lands and Transport (Lands Division), Benin City, shall inquire into objections (if any) duly lodged in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 above at the office at Benin City at 10 a.m. on the 22nd day of August, 1968, giving all parties an opportunity to be heard, and reports thereof shall be sent without delay to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos, who shall decide whether or not the Licence shall be granted.

7. Compensation (if any) payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of the sea bed affected shall be determined by negotiations between the Company and those whose interest or interests are affected.
