# Bureau for External aid for Education Overseas Scholarships—1970

Policy.—It is the policy of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria to accept scholarships outside Nigeria at institutions of Higher learning that will provide supplementary facilities to those available in this country and which will support its high level man-power policy.

During the course of the year, scholarship offers are made to Nigeria by various foreign governments and organisations. Whether these scholarships are made direct to the Nigerian Government or to Organisations and private individuals in this country, all offers shall as a matter of policy be made to the Nigerian Government in the first instance. The offer is received on behalf of the Nigerian Government by the Ministry of External Affairs which then passes it to the Bureau for External Aid for Education, for evaluation and processing.

Fields.—In support of this policy, Overseas Scholarships are expected to be made available in all branches of study at the post-graduate level, and primarily in the following fields of study at the undergraduate level:

Agriculture Foreign Languages Agricultural Economics Geology Anthropology Librarianship Archaeology Mathematics Architecture Medicine Banking Metallurgy **Business Administration** Pharmacy Commercial Art Psychology Dentistry Science Economics Sociology Engineering Statistics Estate Management Surveying Fine Art Town Planning Forestry Veterinary Science

Basic qualifications.—Candidates for undergraduate awards must have a good basic secondary school education leading up to the West African School Certificate or General Certificate of Education or other equivalent qualifications plus at least two papers at Advanced Level in subjects related to intended university course. Some candidates with very good ordinary level results at W.A.S.C. or G.C.E. will be considered for a very limited number of countries. Candidates with approved technical qualifications such as those of City and Guilds of London Institute and who show evidence of practical experience may apply for vocational and advanced technical scholarships.

Candidates for post-graduate awards should have or expect to receive by June 1970 a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent.
