

THE TREASURY BILLS (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1970



Decree No. 15

[1st January 1970]

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :—

1.—(1) In section 3 (2) of the Treasury Bills Act 1959 (which, as amended by the Finance Decree 1969, provides that the principal sums represented by any Treasury Bills outstanding at any one time shall not exceed the federal estimated revenue), for the words “estimated revenue of the Federal Government”, there shall be substituted the words “one hundred and fifty per cent of the estimated revenue retained by the Federal Government and gross revenues of the States”.

(2) Accordingly, section 1 of the said Finance Decree 1969 shall be amended as follows—

(a) in subsection (1) thereof for the words “subsections 2 and 3” there shall be substituted the words “subsection 3”; and

(b) subsection (2) thereof shall stand repealed.

2.—(1) This Decree may be cited as the Treasury Bills (Amendment) Decree 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

**THE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (1969-70)
DECREE 1970**

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. The total of the amounts mentioned in section 1 of the Appropriation Decree 1969 shall be increased by one million seventy-two thousand, seven hundred and forty pounds and this additional amount shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule hereto; and section 1 (3) of the Appropriation Decree 1968 (which provides for the lapse of balances outstanding at the end of the financial year) shall be construed subject to this Decree.

**NIGERIAN RESEARCH INSTITUTES (AMENDMENT) DECREE
1970**

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :—

1. Section 1 of the Nigerian Research Institutes Act 1964 is hereby amended in subsection (2) by deleting paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following new paragraph, that is—

“(a) the production and products of cashew, cocoa, coffee, cola and of such other crops as the Commissioner may from time to time determine in the case of the Cocoa Institute ;”
