Whereas by section 4 (1) of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and as amended in respect of Kano State by section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State and in respect of North-Western State by section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State it is provided that the Sharia Court of Appeal shall consist of a Grand Kadi and not less than two other Judges learned in the Sharia :

AND WHEREAS by section 54 (3) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1967, it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal other than the Grand Kadi is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Grand Kadi or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualification as may be prescribed by law for a person to hold the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal, to act in the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal :

NOW THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint UMARU BIDA to act as Judge of Sharia Court of Appeal of Kano State and of North-Western State from 31st December 1970 to 10th January 1971.

WHEREAS by section 4 (1) of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Sharia Court of Appeal shall consist of a Grand Kadi, a Deputy Grand Kadi and three other Judges learned in the Sharia :

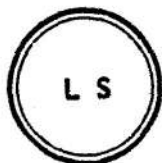
AND WHEREAS by section 54 (2) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that if the person holding the office of the Grand Kadi is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, those functions shall be performed by such one of the other Judges of the Sharia Court of Appeal as may from time to time be designated in that behalf by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee :

NOW THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint JUBIR DAURA to act as Grand Kadi of the Sharia Court of Appeal of the Northern States with effect from 15th January 1971.

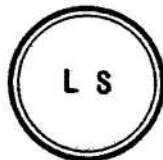
