GENERAL Y. GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of the Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the High Court of the Western State shall consist of the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (1) of the Constitution of the Western State modified as aforesaid it is provided that the Chief Justice and the other Judges of the High Court shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:


Now Therefore, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint Mr Justice Moses Olatunji Oyemade as Chief Justice of the Western State with effect from 9th February 1972.
