

APPROPRIATION DECREE 1972



Decree No. 11

[1st April 1972]

Commence-
ment.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :—

1.—(1) The Accountant-General of the Federation may, when authorised so to do by warrants signed by the Federal Commissioner for Finance, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation during the year ending 31st March 1973 the sums specified by the warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate six hundred and thirty-eight million, nine hundred and forty-seven thousand and six hundred and forty-nine pounds.

Issue and appropriation of £638,947,649 from Consolidated Revenue Fund for 1972-73.

(2) The amount mentioned in the foregoing subsection shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule to this Decree.

(3) No part of the amount aforesaid shall be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation after the end of the year mentioned in subsection (1) of this section.

2.—(1) This Decree may be cited as the Appropriation Decree 1972 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

Citation, extent and commencement.

(2) This Decree shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April 1972.
