FEDERAL GOVERNMENT BURSARIES FOR THE TRAINING OF TEACHERS FOR EDUCA-TIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN NIGERIA 1978-79

In pursuance of the Federal Government's policy of training well qualified teachers for all the educational institutions in the country, applications for bursaries are hereby invited from interested candidates who wish to take up Teaching as a career,

- 2. Applications from students who are pursuing courses in Nigerian Universities and Advanced Teachers' College, designed to equip them to teach in post-primary institutions or hold position of responsibility in primary schools, will be considered.
- 3. Bursaries are tenable at Advanced Teacher's Training Colleges, Colleges of Education and Universities in Nigeria only, and would cover; Tuition and Boarding fees (where applicable) and Teaching Practice fees and Book Allowance.
- 4. Qualifications.—Eligible candidates are students already in the institutions mentioned in paragraph 5 below or those who have obtained admissions into such institutions. For avoidance of doubt, students in Schools of Basic Studies and those in Preliminary classes or equivalents in Universities are not eligible for consideration. Such students can only apply after admission into a degree course in a Faculty of Education.
- 5. Method of Application.—(i) Each candidate should complete one copy of application form which is obtainable, FREE OF CHARGE, from any of the following:—
 - (a) Principals, Advanced Teachers' Colleges (except Federal Advanced Teachers' Colleges);

- (b) Provost, Colleges of Education ;
- (c) Registrars, Department of Education in Technical Institutions;
- (d) Deans of Faculties of Education in Nigerian Universities.
- (ii) Candidates are strongly advised to obtain application forms from the particular institutions where they have been offered admissions or where they are already pursuing courses. Applications on cyclostyled/type-written forms will be rejected. Any false information by a candidate will also lead to his disqualification.
- 6. Time Schedule for Submission of Forms.—
 (a) Candidates should complete Part I of the application forms and submit same to their Principals, Provosts and Deans (as appropriate) not later than 15th October, 1978.
- (b) Principals, Provosts and Deans should complete Part II (two) of the application forms and submit them en bloc DIRECT to the Assistant Director of Education, c/o Teachers' Bursary Section, Federal Ministry of Education, Lagos, to reach him not later than 15th November, 1978. Envelopes containing application forms must be clearly marked "TEACHERS' BURSARIES" and despatched by registered post or preferrably delivered by hand.
- The Federal Ministry of Education will not accept any application direct from any individual. Late application forms will also not be considered.
