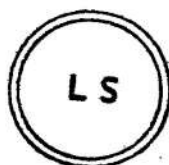

AS MODIFIED BY THE CONSTITUTION (SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION) DECREE 1966
AND THE STATES (CREATION AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) DECREE 1967

WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of the former Western Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Western State shall be the Chief Justice of Western State and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (3) of the Constitution of the former Western Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree and as amended by the Constitution of the Western State (Amendment) Decree 1970 it is provided that if the office of Chief Justice of the State is vacant or if the person holding the office is unable to perform the functions of his office, then, until a person has been appointed to and has assumed the functions of that office or until the person holding the office has assumed those functions, as the case may be, those functions shall be performed by such one of the Justices of the Court of Appeal of the State or of the other Judges of the High Court of the State as may from time to time be designated in that behalf by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MR JUSTICE EDWARD ADEGBOYEGA ADEMOLA, Justice of Appeal, Western State Court of Appeal, to act as Chief Justice of the High Court of Western State with effect from 17th of September, 1973 during the absence on leave of the Chief Justice, Mr M. O. Oyemade.

WHEREAS by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966, the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and the Constitution (Northern States) (Amendment) Decree 1969 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of each of the States created out of the former Northern Nigeria shall be the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than two) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (6) of the said Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria modified as aforesaid it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform

the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court :

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint SALIHU MODDIBO ALFA BELGORE to act as a Judge of the High Court of North-Central State and of the High Court of Kwara State with effect from 27th July, 1973 when Mr Justice Wheeler proceeds on vacation leave, until the Katsina Assizes commencing on 21st August, 1973, are completed ; and then with effect from 15th October, 1973 when Mr Justice Bello goes on leave until his resumption of duty from leave.
