(d) prepare instructions and procedures for the operation of the laboratory and workshop, as well as for keeping an inventory of the stockroom;

(e) provide practical training to local personnel in the repair, maintenance and calibration of instruments;

(f) assist in the training of inspectors of the network;

(g) assist in the preparation of the syllabus of Meteorological School, within the field of his competence.

Qualifications.—The candidates should have a diploma in mechanical, electrical or instruments engineering from a recognised technical institute or have equivalent qualifications.

They should have had extensive experience in the maintenance and repair of all types of meteorological instruments, including those with electrical or electronic components.

Language.—Good knowledge of spoken and written Spanish is essential.

Salary level.—Initial net salary equivalent of US \$11,283.00 per annum, plus allowances.

* **Allowances :**

1. **Post adjustment.**—This adjustment is variable according to cost of living at the duty station. At present, for Montevideo, the equivalent of US \$332.00 per annum is payable for an expert without dependants and the equivalent of US \$498.00 per annum is payable for an expert with dependants.
