FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES

## DIVISION OF HUMAN BIOLOGY AND BEHAVIOUR

#### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The Faculty of Health Sciences was formally instituted in the University of Ife in 1970 after three years of careful planning and upon the demand of the Government of the Western State in 1967 that a Medical School be created in the State.

Foundation students were actually admitted into the Faculty in September 1972, though a group of prospective health sciences students had been admitted for the University Preliminary Course in the Faculty of Science in September 1971.

Throughout its first session, the Faculty was accommodated in the premises of the Faculty of Pharmacy. The Division of Human Biology and Behaviour is now housed in Block D of the Biological Sciences and Pre-clinical buildings. The Divisions of Hospital Care, and Community and Nursing Care are temporarily housed in the premises of the University Health Centre which itself became the first of the Faculty's Community Health Centres for service, teaching and research in Primary Health Care.

#### ACADEMIC ORGANISATION

The Faculty is organised into functional Divisions, not traditional Departments so that integrated teaching shall be more easily achieved.

The following are the Divisions as currently approved by the Senate and Council:

- 1. Division of Human Biology and Behaviour
- 2. Division of Sciences of Pathology
- 3. Division of Community and Nursing Care
- 4. Division of Hospital Care.

Division of Human Biology and Behaviour.—The Division gives instructions and conducts research in the study of the normal structure and function of the human body including the procedures for investigating them and the parameters for recognising variations of normal.

The Division also instructs the students and conducts research on the nature of drugs and the effect of drugs on the body. In co-ordination with the Division of Hospital Care, it guides the students in the proper use of drugs and instructs them on the dangers of abuse of drugs. The Division also provides health care services in the form of consultation as regards the scientific basis of health care.

The Division is governed by a Divisional Committee under the direction of the Head of Division. This Committee consists of all the Faculty members and Associate Lecturers within the Division as well as representatives of students. It is the function of the Divisional Committee, amongst others, to:

- (1) formulate and periodically review the Divisional policies of instruction and service;
- (2) examine and approve the instructional objectives and course contents prepared by the Course Curriculum Planning Committees within

the Division, and ensure proper co-ordination and integration of all courses within the limits set by the Divisional policies;

- (3) receive and approve the evaluation reports of every student within the Division, and authorise feed back to the students through their supervisors;
- (4) report to the relevant Boards of Studies on Divisional policies, instructional objectives, course content, and student performance in all the courses undertaken in the Division.

#### DEGREES OFFERED

The Division of Human Biology and Behaviour offers no degree of its own at present. Staff of the Division contribute to the integrated programme of courses leading to the B.Sc. (Health Sciences) degree of the Faculty. The Division also runs service courses to the Faculty of Pharmacy in various aspects of Human Biology including Physiology and Pharmacology. Plans have also been completed for the Master's programme in Human Biology.

#### RESEARCH INTERESTS AND FACILITIES AVAILABLE

The research interests of members of staff of the Division are varied and cover a wide range of subjects. They include:

- 1. Respiratory Physiology.—(Dr Patrick)—A two-year population study of physique and ventilatory functions in the village of Imesi-Ile, with particular emphasis on growth and development in children and adolescent.
  - 2. Temperature Regulation .- (Dr Durotoye):
  - (i) The mechanisms of endotoxin induced fever. Special emphasis on the role of the viscera in thermogenesis.
  - (ii) Diurnal variation in the body temperature of human subjects in the tropics.
  - (iii) The effect of exercise and changing environmental temperatures on body temperature, sweating rate, cardiac rate and output as well as gaseous exchange.
- 3. Cardiovascular Studies.—(Dr Durotoye)— The effects of commonly used drugs, e.g. Dehydroermetine and Chloroquine on:
  - (a) Blood pressure
  - (b) Regional blood flow
  - (c) Cardiac functions, including:
  - (i) Coronary circulation, using both isolated hearts and intact animals (measuring with Grayson's internal Calorimeter) 1952.
    - (ii) Cardiac work.
- 4. Pharmacology.—(Dr Marquis)—Investigation of the antihypertensive properties of some Nigerian medicinal plants, and their mode of action.

Neuromuscular blocking action of some known alkaloids in Nigerian medicinal plants.

Comparative studies on substance P and/or Histamine in the brain of the African frog, the mouse and the desert rat.

- 1. Developmental Biology.—(Dr Baxter-Grillo)— Histological, histochemical and biochemical studies on the gastro-intestinal tract of the pangolin.
- 2. A longitudinal study of skeletal mituration in Nigerian children.

- 3. Hormones of the developing gastro-intestinal tract.
- Neuropharmacology.—(Dr Grillo)—Integration of sensory information by brain mechanism.
  Role of the hippocampus in the integration of sensory information. Effect of hallucinoganic drugs on the integration of sensory information and possible mechanisms of action of these drugs.
- The effects of psychotropic drugs on cerebrospinal fluid electrolytes.
- 3. The effect of analgesics on brain amines and electrolytes.
- 4. The effect of chloroquine on the electrical activity of the brain.

Endocrinology, Development Biology, Histochemistry and Electron Microscopy.—(T. Adesanya Ige Grillo)—(a) Incorporation of labelled aminoacids into the foetal islet cells and the formation of pro-insulin in the embyonic pancreas.

- (b) Histochemistry and Electron microscopy of the islet cells—a comparative study in reptiles and mammals:—
  - (i) Immuno histochemistry
  - (ii) Autoradiographic studies
  - (iii) Enzyme studies
  - (iv) Electron microscopy.
- (c) Effects of anti-insulin serum of islet cells and pancreatic insulin.
- (d) Studies on a transplantable tumour of the pancreas.
- (e) Insulin assays on blood serum of Nigerians suffering from a pancreatic disease.
- (f) Cytochemical studies of cultured Burkitt Cells.
- (g) Studies on the cytochemistry and electron microscopy of the differentiation and degeneration of red and white muscle.
- (h) Cytochemical changes occuring in virus infections (with the virologists in Ibadan).
  - (i) Pro-insulin and glucagon in foetal pancreas.
- (j) Methods in Enzyme histochemistry, e.g. Phosphomidase.

Neuro-Physiology.—(i) (Dr Uchiyama)—Studies on the Electrical Responses of the Auditory Neurons in tropical insectivorous bats.

(ii) (Dr Arighede)—Studies on the superior colliculus and auditory system.

Circulation and Respiratory Physiology.—(Dr Iweka)—(a) Blood flow in the liver.

(b) Respiratory physiology.

Neuro-Anatomy.—(Dr C. K. Momoh)—(a) Quantitative and qualitative—Histochemical and electron microscopy methods.

(b) Studies on the Neurons of the development of spinal cord.

Haemopoietic System.—(E. Ademola Caxton-Martins)—Histochemical studies on the human foetal bone marrow and on acute Stem-Cell Leukimia.

Developmental Biology.—(P. O. Ogunnaike)— Replacement of Basal Lamina in the small intestine of the rat.

#### FACILITIES AVAILABLE

The Division has fully equipped Histochemistry, Tissue Culture, Developmental and Radio-Isotope Laboratories.

These laboratories are equipped with the most modern equipment, including the H-U-12 Hitachi and the MINI-SEM MSM-2 Hitachi-Akashi Scanning Electron microscopes, the M-85 Scanning Microdensitometer, and various types of research microscopes—including the Flourescent, the inverted and the Phase contrast microscopes.

The Radio-Isotope suite is equipped with various types of counters and excellent facilities for autoradiography. The Physiological and Pharmacological laboratories are equipped with the most up-to-date Polygraphs, including the Devices M19, MX4 and M2 with facilities for recording virtually all physiological parameters. For blood flow measurements there are facilities including the Devices—pulsed field electromagnetic flow meter.

For gaseous exchange, we have the Servomex paramagnetic O<sub>2</sub> analyser, the Grubb-Parsons Infra-red Carbon dioxide analyser and the Radiometer BMS.3 blood gas analyser.

The Division also has a fully equipped Neurobiology unit—with the most up-to-date equipment for recording nervous activities including EEG.

#### BUILDING

All the teaching and research laboratories of the Division are accommodated within the centrally air-conditioned "Block D" of the new buildings of Biological Sciences and Preclinical Departments.
