Customs and Excise Notice No. 13 published as Government Notice No. 1989 of 1970 as amended by Government Notice No. 703 of 1975 is hereby amended as follows:—

1. Delete paragraph 19 (c) and substitute the following—

"19 (c) Adjustment of Payments/Values under the provisions of paragraphs 19 (a) and (b) will not be made unless the importer, within three months of lodging a provisional Entry, or such longer period as may be allowed by the Board, presents to the proper officer a perfect Entry-Form Sale 42 duly supported by proper invoice and "Certificate of Value by Importer" (see paragraph 8 (c)) and pays the correct amount of duty involved. Refund of the amount of provisional payment will be effected on application in writing within one year reckoned from the date of passing the perfect Entry".

2. Add new paragraph 19 (d) as follows:—

"19 (d) The Proper Officer may on application in writing by the importer, extend the statutory period of three months allowed the importer to deliver a perfect Entry, if he is satisfied that a good reason exists for extending it".
