# SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (1974-75) DECREE 1975



## Decree No. 5

[31st January 1975]

Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1.—(1) The aggregate amount mentioned in section 1 of the Appropriation Decree 1974 shall be increased by one hundred and nineteen million, one hundred and twenty seven thousand, eight hundred naira, and this additional amount shall be appropriated to the heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule to this Decree.

Issue and appropriation of N119,127, 800 from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for services of 1974-75. 1974 No. 19.

2. This Decree may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1974-75) Decree 1975.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Decree increases the amount mentioned in section 1 of the Appropriation Decree 1974 by №119,127,800 and provides that the additional amount shall be appropriated as specified in the Schedule to the Decree.

## CONSTITUTION (FINANCIAL PROVISIONS, ETC.) DECREE 1975



### Decree No. 6

[See section 7(1)]

Commencement.

Amendment of section

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. For section 136 of the Constitution of the Federation there shall be substituted the following new section:—

"Import duties on certain commodities.

- 136.—(1) Where under any Act of Parliament or Decree a duty is levied in respect of the import into Nigeria of any commodity other than motor spirit, diesel oil, tobacco, wine, potable spirits, or beer, the Federation shall, in respect of each quarter, credit to a special account maintained by the Federation (to be called "the Distributable Pool Account") a sum equal to thirty-five per cent of the proceeds of that duty for that quarter.
- (2) For the purposes of this section the proceeds of a duty for a quarter shall be the amount remaining from the receipts from that duty that are collected in that quarter after any drawbacks, refunds or other repayments relating to those receipts have been made or allowed for.
- 2. For section 137 of the Constitution of the Federation, there shall be substituted the following new section:—

"Import duties on motor spirits and tobacco.

- 137.—(1) Where under any Act of Parliament or Decree a duty is levied in respect of import to Nigeria of motor spirit, diesel oil or tobacco, or of any particular class, variety or description of motor spirit, diesel oil or tobacco, the Federation shall, in respect of every quarter, credit to the Distributable Pool Account a sum equal to the proceeds of that duty for that quarter.
- (2) For the purposes of this section the proceeds of a duty for a quarter levied on any commodity, or any particular class, variety or description of commodity shall be the amount remaining from the receipts from that duty that are collected in that quarter after any drawbacks, refunds or other repayments relating to those receipts have been made or allowed for."
- 3. For section 138 of the Constitution of the Federation, there shall be substituted the following new section:—

"Excise duties.

138.—(1) Where under any Act of Parliament or Decree an excise duty is levied on any commodity, the Federation shall, in respect of every quarter, credit to the Distributable Pool Account a sum equal to fifty per cent of the proceeds of that

Amendment of section 138 of the Constitution of the Federation. duty for that quarter, and the other fifty per cent of those proceeds for that quarter shall be treated as revenue of the Federation and shall be paid into the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation.

(2) For the purposes of this section the proceeds of a duty for a quarter levied on any commodity, or any particular class, variety or description of commodity, shall be the amount remaining from the receipts from that duty that are collected in that quarter after any drawbacks, refunds or other repayments relating to those receipts have been made or allowed for."

Amendment of section 139 of the Constitution of the Federation. 1963 No. 20. 4. For section 139 of the Constitution of the Federation, there shall be substituted the following new section:—

"Export duties.

- 139.—(1) Where under any Act of Parliament or Decree duty is levied in respect of the export from Nigeria of produce, hides or skins, the Federation shall, in respect of every quarter, credit to the Distributable Pool Account a sum equal to the proceeds of that duty for that quarter.
- (2) For the purposes of this section the proceeds for a quarter of a duty levied on a commodity shall be the amount remaining from such of the receipts from that duty as relate to exports of that commodity during that quarter after any drawbacks, refunds or other repayments relating to those receipts have been made or allowed for."

Amendment of section 140 of the Constitution of the Federation. 5. For section 140 of the Constitution of the Federation, there shall be substituted the following new section:—

"Mining royalties.

- 140.—(1) There shall be paid by the Federation to each State a sum equal to twenty per cent of—
  - (a) the proceeds of any royalty received by the Federation in respect of any minerals extracted in that State; and
  - (b) any mining rents derived by the Federation from within that State.
- (2) The Federation shall credit to the Distributable Pool Account a sum equal to eighty per cent of—
  - (a) the proceeds of any royalty received by the Federation in respect of minerals extracted from any State; and
  - (b) any mining rents derived by the Federation from any State.
- (3) The Federation shall credit to the Distributable Pool Account—
  - (a) the proceeds of any royalty received by the Federation in respect of minerals extracted from the territorial waters and the continental shelf of Nigeria;
  - (b) any mining rents received by the Federation in respect of the territorial waters and continental shelf of Nigeria.
- (4) For the purposes of this section the proceeds of any royalty shall be the amount remaining from the receipts of that royalty after any refunds or other repayments relating to those receipts have been deducted therefrom or allowed for.

- (5) In this section—
- (a) the reference to "continental shelf" and "territorial waters" are references to those expressions as defined in the Territorial Waters Decree 1967 and the Petroleum Decree 1969; and
  - (b) "minerals" includes mineral oil."
- 6. Immediately after section 140 of the Constitution of the Federation there shall be inserted the following new section:
- "Distribution 141 The amount standing to the credit of the Distributable of funds in Pool Account at the end of each quarter shall be distributed table Pool among the States on the following basis—
- Account.

  (a) one-half shall be divided equally among the States; and
  (b) the other half shall be divided among the States proportionately to the population of each State."
- 7.—(1) This Decree may be cited as the Constitution (Financial Provisions, etc.) Decree 1975 and shall come into force on 1st April 1975.
- (2) The enactments set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Decree are, to the extent set out in the third column of that Schedule, consequentially, repealed.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Decree but is intended to explain its effect)

The Decree amends the Constitution of the Federation to modify in certain respects the current principle of revenue allocation and to provide for an increase in the revenue to be credited by the Federation to the Distributable Pool Account.
