WHEREAS by section 51 (2) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and the Constitution (Basic Provisions) Decree 1975, it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of East-Central State shall be the Chief Justice of East-Central State and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (3) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and the Constitution (Basic Provisions) Decree 1975, it is provided that if the office of Chief Justice of the State is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, then, until a person has been appointed to, and has assumed the functions of that office or until the person holding the office has resumed those functions, as the case may be, those functions shall be performed by such one of the other Judges of the High Court of the State as may from time to time be designated in that behalf by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint ANTHONY NYAMAZA CHRISTOPHER ASTAGOLA to act as the Chief Justice of the High Court of East-Central State with effect from the 19th day of November, 1975.

Also in pursuance of section 19(1) of the Income Tax (Armed Forces and Other Persons) (Special Provisions) Decree 1972, every taxable person under section 1 (1) of this Decree having any income which is chargeable with tax, under the provisions of this Decree, whether personally or in any representative capacity, shall within the period of twenty-one days from the date of this Notice deliver to the understated officer of the Federal Board of Inland Revenue, a complete and accurate statement of his/her income accruing in, derived from, brought into or received in Nigeria for the purposes of assessment to income tax for the year 1976-77.

4. MINIMUM CONDITIONS

- (a) Applicants must produce evidence that they are *bona fide* cocoa farmers;
- (b) Applicants must furnish in duplicate under separate cover, the name/names of their members and the location of their farms in order to facilitate physical checking of the farms and their productive capacity;
- (c) Applicants must produce evidence of necessary organisation to ensure proper performance of the duties of a licensed buying agent;

(i) *Inspection of cocoa*—that they will be able to provide an adequate labour force at all stores to handle cocoa at the time of inspection;

(ii) *Returns*—that they will render promptly and accurately all returns, particularly of gradings and stocks, which may be called for;

(iii) *Evacuation*;

(a) that they will be able to make arrangements to secure the necessary transport to ensure the smooth and regular evacuation of cocoa by approved routes;

(b) that they possess the necessary organisation at port or the ability to secure reliable agents to ensure the carrying out of all duties involved in the delivery of cocoa to Board's Stores.

2. Supervision of routine work of financial

matters and routine audit of the expenditures of the Secretariat ;

3. Preparation of monthly and annual statements of the accounts of the Secretariat and necessary analyses as required ;

4. Recommendations of appropriate policies and procedures concerning the accounting system, budget preparation and auditing services ;

5. Controlling expenditure and ensuring that it does not exceed the relative budget appropriation and that all payments are made in accordance with existing regulations ;
