STATES (CREATION AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) DECREE 1976



Decree No. 12

[3rd February 1976]

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :--

- 1. There shall on the commencement of this Decree be created states

- (3) The fund shall be managed in accordance with regulations made for the purpose by the Military Government of the state concerned, and until the regulations are made the fund shall, subject to any general or special directions of the Military Governor of the state concerned, be managed in accordance with such general rules or regulations as applied, before the commencement of this Decree, with respect to the management of the public funds of the state of which, before the commencement of this Decree, the area of the
- state created under this Decree formed a part. 4.—(1) The Supreme Military Council may from time to time by order published in the Gazette appoint a States Boundaries Adjustment Commission which shall in accordance with the provisions of the order be charged with
- responsibility for adjusting the boundaries of any of the states created under this Decree. (2) Where the boundaries of any state are adjusted by a Commission appointed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, the adjustment shall have effect only after approval by the Supreme Military Council.

- (3) A Commission appointed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall in the performance of its duties under this section comply with any directions of the Supreme Military Council, given to the Commission by the Head of the Federal Military Government.
 - (4) Members of a Commission appointed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall hold office on such terms, including salary and allowances, as may be specified by the Supreme Military Council.
 5.—(1) Until other provision is made by law in that behalf, all existing
 - law (including all law continued in force by virtue of section 1 (5) of the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967) in the state of which, before the commencement of this Decree, the area of the state created under this Decree formed a part shall have effect in the state created under this Decree, subject to the modifications necessary to bring the law into conformity with the provisions of this Decree.
 - (2) Without prejudice to the provision of subsection (1) above, every local authority, court and other public body which immediately before the commencement of this Decree exercised its functions within the area of a state as constituted under this Decree shall continue to exercise those functions in the state.
 (3) Any person who immediately before the commencement of this
 - Decree held office as a member of the public service of a state and exercised his office at or from a place in the area included in a state under this Decree shall, on the commencement of this Decree, unless at any time he is transferred, removed from or resigns his office in the manner provided by law, continue to hold and exercise that office in the state.
- (4) A body corporate or person who continues to exercise any office or function by virtue of this section shall exercise that office or function in accordance with the directions, if any, of the appropriate Military Governor.
 6.—(1) For section 3 of the Constitution of the Federation there shall

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Decree but is intended to explain its purpose)

The Decree creates for Nigeria nineteen states and specifies the areas to be comprised in the states and the location of their respective capitals. It provides for the establishment of a States Boundaries Adjustment Commission which is to have responsibility for adjusting, where necessary, the houndaries of the States. Transitional provisions are made with respect to the administration of the states.
