Both the Auditorium and the Arts Theatre are equipped with the most up-to-date facilities for theatrical presentations and film shows. The Theatre Business Manager, under the supervision of the Director of the Centre for Cultural Studies, will take charge of all theatre business including publicity, printing and sales of tickets, box office, booking of the theatres and booking of accommodation artists. He will also be responsible for ensuring maximum financial returns from the operations of the theatres.

In addition the successful candidate may be required to train members of the Centre's Performing Arts Troupe in the mechanics of theatre business management.

While the Theatre Business Manager will not be discouraged from expressing whatever artistic talents he may have, his primary function will be to provide services for other artists and not to practise as an artist himself. He must therefore be ready to give maximum support to individual artists whose productions he is called upon to mount.
