Certain Persons (Prohibited Immigrants) Order 1983

Commencement : 20th June 1983

I, the Minister of Internal Affairs, being of opinion that the admission into Nigeria of the persons named in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, being nationals of the countries specified in the second column of the said Schedule, would be contrary to the interest of national security and is in accordance with the provisions of section 17 (1) (d) of the Immigration Act 1963, deemed to be prohibited immigrants, and acting under the powers conferred upon me by section 17 of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, order that the said persons be refused admission into Nigeria accordingly.

2. This Order may be cited as the Certain Persons (Prohibited Immigrants) Order 1983. Citation.
