(e) Co-ordinate the work of the Directors as well as the work of other agencies engaged in collecting statistics through the co-ordinating machinery set up by Government. Give technical guidance where necessary and offer advice to government on all statistical matters;

(f) Responsible for budgetary control over the entire Federal Office of Statistics;

(g) Liaison with international agencies; and

(h) General Administrative matters including Staff training and manpower development.

(ii) Director, Grade Level 16—

(a) He will be directly responsible to the co-ordinating Director for providing the necessary professional support for policy formulation, planning, design and execution of statistical programmes relating to his Department;

(b) Direct and supervise statistical operations relevant to his Department in the areas of survey planning and execution and publishing of reports; and

(c) General Administrative matters and control of finance relating to his Department.
