CRIMINAL CODE ACT, (CAPC38, LFN 2004) Dissolution and Proscription of Certain Associations Order, 2013

[28th August, 2013]

Commencement.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 62 (2) (ii) of the Criminal Code Act Cap, C38, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Dr. Goodluck Ebele Jonathan, GCFR, President, Federal Republic of Nigeria, make the following Order:

1.—(1) As from the commencement of this Order, the Associations specified in the Schedule to this Order whose activities have been found to be interfering with, resisting and encouraging interference with the administration of Law and disturbing or encouraging the disturbance of peace, security and order in Nigeria are dissolved and proscribed.

Dissolution and Proscription of certain Associations, etc.

- (2) The Associations dissolved and proscribed pursuant to paragragh (1) of this Order shall cease to carry out the activities, duties or functions for which they were formed.
 - (3) No person shall:
 - (a) manage, take part in or encourage the management of any of the dissolved and proscribed associations;
 - (b) take part in any meeting of any dissolved and proscribed associations whether or not such meetings take place in public or in private premises; or
 - (c) take part in any procession conducted by any of the dissolved and proscribed associations or any person associated with the association or acting in furtherance of the aims of the association.
- 2. As from the commencement of this Order, the dissolved and Proscribed associations shall not be formed into any new associations by whatever name or title, within the meaning of this Order.
- Prohibition of the formation of similar Associations.
- 3.—(1) Any duly authorised member of the Nigerian Police or Armed Forces may enter, with the assistance of such number of other members of the Nigerian Police or Armed Forces or other persons as may be deemed necessary in any appropriate case, any house, building or any other place whatsoever in which he has reason to believe that a meeting of any dissolved and proscribed association under this Order or persons who were members of such association is being held.
- Power of the Police or Armed Forces in relation to any dissolved and proscribed Association.
- (2) Any duly authorised member of the Nigerian Police or Armed Forces may arrest any person found in such house, building or place whom he has reasonable cause to believe is or was connected with any of the dissolved and proscribed associations or is connected with the purposes of such association or meeting.

Citation.

4. This Order may be cited as the Dissolution and Proscription of Certain Associations Order, 2013.
