**WHEREAS** by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 63 of the Constitution, it is ordained that the President may, acting in accordance with the advice of a Committee appointed by the Cabinet over which the Vice-President shall preside grant any person convicted of any offence against the laws of Sierra Leone a pardon, either free or subject to lawful conditions:

**AND WHEREAS AHMED SANKAY DIAN-TURAY** was on the 29th day of March 1978 convicted before the High Court at Freetown in the Western Area of the Republic of Sierra Leone for the offences of Obtaining Money by False Pretences, Larceny, Falsification of Accounts and Conspiracy to Defraud, and was thereupon by the said court imposed punishment of fines or imprisonment in default thereof:

**AND WHEREAS** on the 27th day of January 1981 the Court of Appeal allowed the appeal of the said **AHMED SANKAY DIAN-TURAY** against his conviction:

**AND WHEREAS** on the 13th day of July 1982 the Supreme Court allowed the appeal by the State on some counts thereby restoring the conviction on those counts against the said **AHMED SANKAY DIAN-TURAY** for the offences of Obtaining Money by False Pretences, Larceny and Falsification of Accounts:

**AND WHEREAS** the said **AHMED SANKAY DIAN-TURAY** did pay the fines imposed by the High Court and upheld by the Supreme Court:

**AND WHEREAS** acting in accordance with the advice of the aforesaid Committee, I now consider it expedient that my mercy should be extended to the said **AHMED SANKAY DIAN-TURAY**:

**NOW THEREFORE**, by virtue and in exercise of the powers aforesaid in the Constitution vested in me, being so advised by the Committee hereby grants unto the said **AHMED SANKAY DIAN-TURAY** a free pardon for the offences whereof he was so convicted as aforesaid.
