## LEGAL NOTICE NO. 5 OF 1977

## THE TRADING LICENCES ORDER, 1975

(No. 20 of 1975)

## THE TRADING LICENCES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1977

(Under section 20)

*(Date of commencement: 21st. January, 1977)*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the above-mentioned Order, the Minister for Commerce and Co-operatives is pleased to make the following regulations —

*Citation.*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trading Licences (Amendment) Regulations, 1977.

*Interpretation.*

2. In these regulations, the "principal regulations" means the Trading Licences Regulations, 1975, published under Legal Notice No. 108 of 1975.

*Amendment of Item 17 of Schedule "B" to the principal regulations.*

3. Item 17 of Schedule "B" to the principal regulations is amended by replacing it by the following —

"Item 17 : (Grocer General Business Area)	E50.00
Rural Area	E15.00

(1) This licence should be required by every person who carries on the trade or business of selling, bartering, exchange, or offering for sale, barter or exchange, any groceries:

Provided that a holder of general dealer's licence who carries on the trade or business of a general dealer in his licensed premises shall not require this licence.

(2) For purposes of this item, "groceries" means all foodstuffs (except fresh meat and fish) and includes non-alcoholic drinks, soap, candles, paraffin, matches, cigarettes and tobacco:

Provided that if the trade or business operated under this licence is situate in a rural area "groceries" also includes patent medicines, stationery, torch and radio batteries, razor blades, methylated spirits, benzine, paraffin lamps, show laces, toilet paper, locks, and keys and pocket knives.

## S2

*Addition of Items 29 to 37 in Schedule "B" to the principal regulations.*

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding in Schedule "B" thereof the following new items immediately after Item 28 —

Item 29 : Driving Instructor E50.00

(1) This licence shall be required by every person who for a reward teaches or gives instructions to any other person the art or skill of driving a motor vehicle.

(2) For the purpose of this item, "motor vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it in the Road Traffic Act, 1965.

Item 38 : Dealer or Speculator in Livestock E40.00

(1) This licence shall be required by every person who carries on the trade or business of buying livestock for the purpose of sale, consignment, barter, or exchange or who, as an employee of a person carrying business as a dealer or speculator in livestock, conducts such business on behalf of his employer, whether by auction or out of hand and whether or not such person has a recognised place of business:

Provided that a farmer or breeder of livestock shall not require this licence in respect of the sale, barter or exchange of livestock bred by him in Swaziland or purchased and resold in the course of his ordinary farming operations.

(2) Every such licence shall be issued in the name of one individual only:

Provided that if such licence is issued to a company or partnership it shall also specify the name of the individual using it and the name of such individual may be changed by a licensing officer without any additional charge, upon the request of the company or partnership.

Item 31 : Blacksmith E10.00

(1) This licence shall be required by every person who carries on the trade or business of a blacksmith and shall entitle the holder thereof to sell materials ordinarily used in connection with such trade.

Item 32 : Billiard Table Keeper E40.00  
(for each table)

(if not on premises held under E20.00  
a licence for the sale of  
intoxicating liquor)

for each table)

This licence shall be required by every person who keeps a billiard table for public use, whether or not a charge is made for the right to play and shall not be granted unless a certificate, issued by a police officer of the rank of sub inspector upwards, that the person to whom it is to be issued is of good character has been produced to the licensing officer.

Item 33 : Green grocer E75.00

This licence shall be required by every person who carries on the trade or business of a greengrocer.

Item 34 : Funeral undertaker E20.00

This licence shall be required by every person who carries on the trade or business of a funeral undertaker.

Item 35 : Discotheque Keeper E100.00  
(mobile discotheque) E 30.00

This licence shall be required by every person carrying the business of keeping a discotheque for reward.

Item 36 : Miller E100.00  
(in the case of purchasing and  
Milling for sale)

(in the case of milling for  
customers) 5.00

This licence shall be required in respect of every mill by any person who carries on the trade or business of purchasing and milling, or grinding sugar cane, nuts, cotton or any seed into sugar, flour, meal or other products for sale and in the case of cereals, only for sale as a whole grain or who carries on the trade or business of milling sugar, grinding nuts, cotton or other seeds into flour, meal or other products for reward in cash or kind.
