THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS' (EXAMINATIONS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1986

(Under section 33)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 33 of the Legal Practitioners Act, 1964, and after consultation with a committee convened under that section, the Chief Justice hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Practitioners' (Examinations) (Amendment) Regulations, 1986, shall be read as one with the Legal Practitioners' (Examinations) Regulations, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and shall come into force on the 17th November, 1986.

Amendment of regulation 3.

2. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended by adding after sub-regulation (a) (xix) the following—

“(xx) the examination prescribed by the former University of Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland and the former University of Botswana and Swaziland and the University of Swaziland for the degree of bachelor of arts in law.
