LEGAL NOTICE NO. 36 OF 2004

THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963
(Act No. 35 of 1963)

**THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MINING LEGISLATION DRAFTING
COMMITTEE NOTICE, 2004**
(Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister for Natural Resources and Energy issues the following notice -

Citation

1. This Notice may be cited as the Mining Legislation Drafting Committee Notice, 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st March, 2004.

Appointment of Members of the Committee

2. There is established a Committee to be known as the Mining Legislation Drafting Committee (in this Notice referred to as the "Committee") and shall consist of the following persons -

Functions of the Committee

3. The Committee shall-

- (a) review the mining legislation and other mining regulatory instruments;
- (b) ensure institutional arrangements for the administration and implementation of the mining legislation are put in place;
- (c) prepare mining legislation drafts and review mining agreements;
- (d) consult government and other stakeholders in the course of preparing drafts;

- (e) obtain advice and assistance from the Commonwealth and subject to availability of funds, seek advice from other experts;
- (f) carry out other functions and duties relevant to this Notice as the Minister may, in writing, order the Committee to perform; and
- (g) produce and deliver final mining legislation drafts to the Minister.

Appointment of a Secretariat

4. (1) The Committee shall have a secretariat composed of the following persons -

- (a) **Ms Nomcebo Msibi; and**
- (b) **Mr Charles Mhlanga.**

(2) The Minister may remove, without giving reasons, any member of the secretariat for the better carrying out of the secretariat.

Functions of the Secretariat

5. The Secretariat shall -

- (a) provide secretarial services to the Committee;
- (b) arrange consultative meetings; and
- (c) perform such other functions as may be lawfully given to such bodies as this secretariat.

Submission of Draft

6. (1) The Committee shall produce and submit a mining legislation drafts to the Minister.

(2) The drafts mentioned in Section 3 (g) shall be delivered by the Committee not later than the 1st March, 2006.

Meetings

7. (1) The Committee shall meet at least four times a month at a place and time as the Chairman of the Committee may determine.

(2) The Committee shall make rules for the regulation of its business and procedure relating to its meetings.

Allowances and Reimbursements

8. The members of the Committee shall be entitled to sitting allowances and, where applicable, reimburse for travelling expenses in accordance with the Finance Circular No. 4 of 1998.

Extension of time

9. The Minister may, by Notice published in the gazette, extend the time specified under Section 6 (2).
