## LEGAL NOTICE NO. 120 OF 2005

### THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963 (Act No. 35 of 1963)

#### THE APPOINTMENT OF THE JOB CREATION STEERING COMMITTEE NOTICE, 2005 (Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister for Enterprise and Employment hereby issues the following Notice:

#### *Citation and Commencement*

1. This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the Job Creation Steering Committee Notice, 2005 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2005

#### *Establishment and Composition of Committee*

2. There is established a Committee to be known as the Job Creation Steering Committee (herein referred to as "the Committee") which shall be composed of the following persons -

***Functions of the Committee***

3. The Committee shall perform the following functions -
  - (i) resource mobilization

- (ii) stakeholder consultations.
- (iii) monitoring and implementing decisions taken during the Job Creation summit.
- (iv) education the nation, using all the Tinkhundla centres, on the objectives and decisions of the Job Creation Summit.
- (v) receive and scrutinise applications for business start-up loans.
- (vi) preparation of Summit reports and submission to Cabinet sub-committee (chairman and Secretariat).
- (vii) providing linkages with the E1 Billion Job Creation Investment Committee.
- (viii) preparation of topics and issues for discussion for education sessions.

***Duration***

- 4. (I) The duration of the committee shall be a period of 16 weeks.
- (II) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Minister may by published notice Published in the gazette, extend the period of the enquiry.

***Allowances***

- 5. The Committee shall be entitled to such allowances and, where applicable, re-imbusement for travelling expenses in accordance with Finance Circular No. 4 of 1998

***Frequency of meetings***

- 6. The Committee shall meet once a week and as often as it may be necessary to carry out its functions.

***Quorum***

- 7. The chairperson and eight members shall constitute a quorum.

***Report***

- 8. The Committee shall submit a report on its functions to the Minister on Job Creation every 2 weeks from the date of appointment and whenever so required by the Minister.
