B.G.—(Primings, Lugs and Cutters). To comprise all leaf from B.B. and B.D. with limited *improving* green in veins and adjacent to midribs. Spotting must not exceed 15 per cent and only slight other blemishings allowed.

T.B.—(Leaf Fillers and Tips). Bright to mahogany in colour. Ripe medium to full bodied mature leaf. Spotting must not exceed 20 per cent and only slight other blemishings allowed.

T.G.—(Leaf Fillers and Tips). To comprise all leaf from T.B. with limited *improving* green in veins and adjacent to midribs. Spotting must not exceed 20 per cent and only slight other blemishings allowed.

M.—Sound ripe leaf from all positions on the plant which cannot qualify for the grades B.B., B.D. and T.B. Medium degrees of blemishings, spotting and other defects allowed.

N.—All ripe leaf, irrespective of colour or plant position, which cannot qualify for grade M due to more severe blemishings and other defects. Also all leaf which would otherwise qualify for grades M and N, carrying an *improving* green in lamina, veins and midribs to be placed in this grade; leaf with an *improving* green cast, i.e. carrying more green than is acceptable in B.G. or T.G., may also be included.

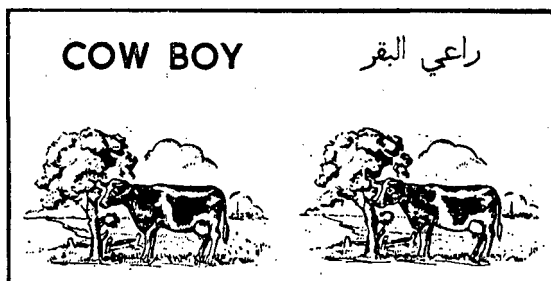
