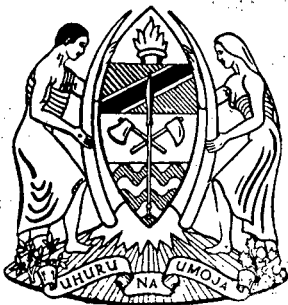

SALE OF STANDING TIMBER BY TENDER

Applications for an exclusive 5-year licence, the details of which are given below, are invited from interested parties.

1. The amounts available are:—

- 50,000 cu. ft. per annum of E.A. cypress (*Cupressus lusitanica*) standing at Sungwi in the Shume/Magamba Forest Reserve; and
- approximately 15,000 cu. ft. per year (75,000 cu. ft. over the 5-year licence period) of standing softwood thinnings in the 8"-12" butt diameter class from established plantations in the Shume area.

2. All logs from the Sungwi cypress over 6' 6" in length and having a girth over bark at the smaller end of 18 inches or more, and which are less than 50 per cent defective shall be classed as usable. Defect rebates will be granted in the proportion of defective timber up to a maximum of 50 per cent of the tendered fees. The following shall not be regarded as defects—branches which cause knots in the timber unless these knots are loose or rotten; small size of logs; spiral grain; sapwood where this is sound; stain; splits or shakes caused by careless felling or extraction.

3. Tenders will be considered on the basis of:—

1. The annual premium (to be paid in advance) which the applicant is prepared to pay for the exclusive cutting rights. *No tender for less than Shs. 2,000/- (two thousand shillings) per annum will be accepted.*

2. The forest fees which the applicant is prepared to pay in addition to the premium for timber measured in true cubic feet under bark (in accordance with the Log Volume Tables in the Forest Rules and the Forest Division's Log Volume Tables for Softwoods) for each of the two categories listed in paragraph 1 above on the understanding that:—

- no distance rebate will be granted;
- if the standard fees published in the Forest Rules are altered, the tendered fees will be altered in the same proportion.

3. The capital available in terms of money and equipment which the applicant will make available for the efficient working of the concession.

4. The type and efficiency of the machinery which the applicant proposes to use to extract the trees taken under the licence as judged by the Chief Conservator of Forests.

5. Properly stated plans for the promotion of African participation in the enterprise with particular reference to:—

- The training of the forest labour force in proper methods of felling, cross-cutting and logging so that they may, if they wish, form themselves into a "Loggers Co-operative".
- The training of staff and employees in sawmilling, maintenance and timber marketing.
- Other forms of participation such as partnership.

These plans must also be submitted with the tender.

3. The felling areas must be inspected before tendering and no tender will be accepted unless the applicant certifies that this has been done.

Under section 40 (1)

1. It is hereby declared that, subject to the conditions set out below, the funds of the National Union of Tanganyika Workers may be expended on the following additional objects of the Union, namely:—

"to finance and administer the Workers' Development Corporation (T) Limited".

2. The conditions are:—

- That a copy of the approved Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account to be maintained by the Workers' Development Corporation (T) Limited shall be submitted to the Registrar of Trade Unions annually, within thirty days of the holding of the Corporation's General Meeting.
- That at least two-thirds of the Directors of the Corporation shall at all times be members of the General Council of the National Union of Tanganyika Workers.
- That the Corporation shall notify the Registrar of Trade Unions of all and every change of Directors of the Corporation.
- That a levy for the purpose of raising funds for investment in the Corporation shall only be imposed by the National Union of Tanganyika Workers in the manner prescribed by the Union's rules.
- That all funds of the Union to be invested in the Corporation shall be approved by the Minister for Labour in accordance with Rule 36 (2) of the Union's rules.
- That details of the amounts invested in the Corporation shall specifically be exhibited in the Annual Statement of Income and Expenditure of the Union.
- A statement of the total amounts invested in the Corporation on the 31st December of the year preceding the Bi-Annual Congress of the Union shall be presented to the Bi-Annual Congress on each occasion it meets.
- Every change or alteration to the Articles of Association of the Corporation shall be notified to the Registrar of Trade Unions.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN NATIONAL UNION OF TANGANYIKA WORKERS AND MESSRS. JASHBHAI P. PATEL AND CO., NEGOTIATED BEFORE MR J. K. MUGUNDA, LABOUR OFFICER APPOINTED BY THE LABOUR COMMISSIONER UNDER SECTION 3 (2) OF THE ACT

The Trade Disputes (Settlement) Act
(No. 43 of 1962)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

We, the accredited representatives of NUTA hereinafter referred to as the "Union" and Messrs. Jashbhai P. Patel and Co., hereinafter referred to as the "Employer" being parties to a trade dispute reported to the Labour Commissioner on the 15th July, 1965, and having agreed on the 8th August, 1965, on the terms as set out below in respect of certain of the issues reported as being in dispute now in witness thereof have appended our signatures hereto.

ARTICLE I

The employer agrees to accord full recognition to the Union as the sole bargaining body for and on behalf of all the employees and further agrees to negotiate with the Union only or its designated representatives, all matters affecting relationship between the employer and employees.

ARTICLE II

Hours of Work.

We hereby agree that working hours shall be 45 per week i.e. from Monday to Friday (eight) hours per day and on Saturday 5 (five) hours only.

ARTICLE III

Probationary Period.

It is agreed that all employees on engagement shall be considered to be on probation for a period of one month during which period either party the employer or the employee shall give the other a day's notice of intention to terminate employment. Employees other than those on probation will be employed on monthly terms.

ARTICLE IV

Over-time.

We have agreed that over-time shall be paid at $1\frac{1}{2}$ times the basic rate in excess of normal working hours on Article II and for employees who may be required for essential services, double pay shall be paid to any employee worked on Public Holidays or Sundays.

ARTICLE V

Leave with Pay.

It is agreed that on completion of one year's service all employees shall be entitled to eighteen days leave with pay.

ARTICLE VI

Sick Leave.

We both agreed that in the event of illness or absence from work for same reasons such employee or employees shall be entitled to one month's full pay and in case of continuous illness one month's half pay.

ARTICLE VII

Travel Facilities.

We have both agreed that, employees will get Shs. 50/- each when proceeding on leave.

ARTICLE VIII

House Allowance.

It is agreed that the house allowance be withdrawn.

ARTICLE IX

Wages.

It is agreed that increase of wages will be as follows:—

- (i) Employees receiving Shs. 160/- to 200/- per month will get an increase of Shs. 20/-;
- (ii) Employees receiving Shs. 201/- to 400/- per month will get an increase of Shs. 30/-;
- (iii) Employees receiving Shs. 400/- and over, will get an increase of Shs. 40/-.

ARTICLE X

Duration of Agreement.

This agreement shall remain in force for the period from 1st September, 1965 to thirty-first day of August, 1966 after which either party may for the intention to review this agreement give thirty days notice to that effect.

Observation.

Both the company and the Union have expressed the wish that, this agreement shall apply to all other employers engaged in transport within the City of Dar es Salaam since there are no fixed standards prevailing on any of the issues raised by the Union and therefore, to limit this agreement to Messrs. Jashbhai Patel & Company would be tantamount to penalizing them.

Both parties therefore, are now requesting the Labour Commissioner to present their request to the Minister for extending this agreement to such employers.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by virtue of the provisions of section 5 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Settlement) Act (No. 43 of 1962), I hereby endorse the aforesaid negotiated agreement which should henceforth be deemed to be an Award within the meaning of sections 2 and 25 (1) of the Act.

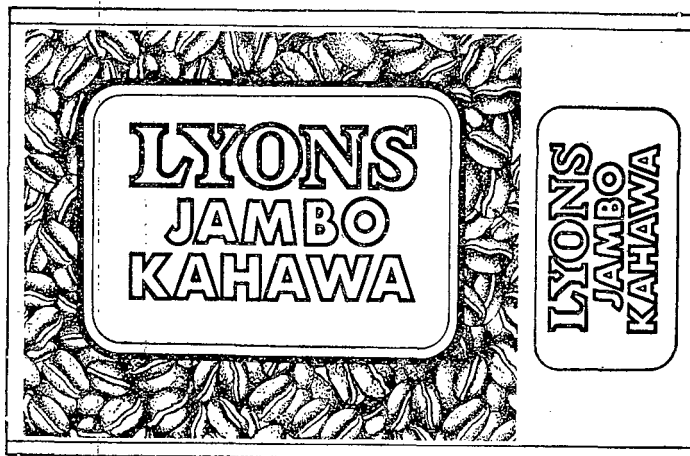

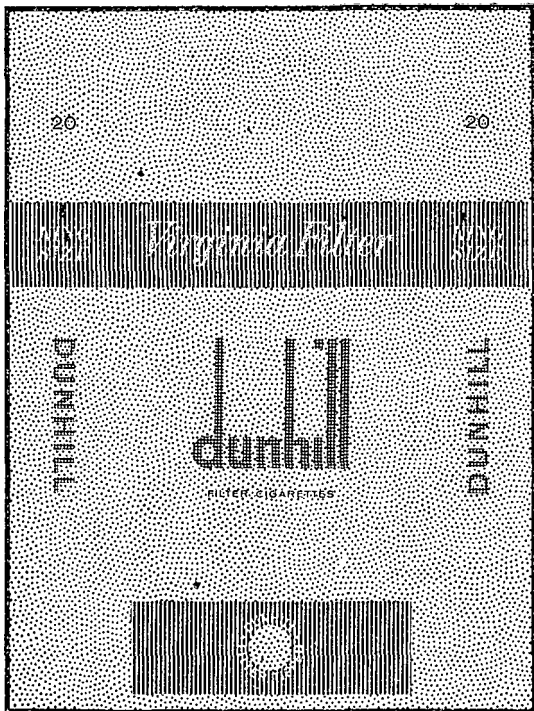
