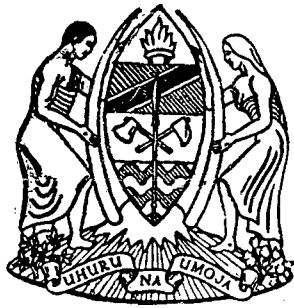

VACANCIES IN THE SERVICE OF THE EAST AFRICAN COMMON SERVICES ORGANIZATION

Applications are invited for the following posts and should be submitted to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, P.O. Laboratory Technician, E.A. Institute of Medical Research, Mwanza.

Salary scale: TO. III/II: £670-£1,060. (Pensionable).

Applicants must have the A.I.M.L.T. or A.I.S.T. The work is mainly concerned with research into the medical and biological aspects of bilharzia. The work is varied and may include morbid, histology, haematology, parasitology, and experimental work with primates and snails.

The point of entry in the scale will depend on qualification and experience. Housing is available.

Veterinary Research or Research Officer (Physiologist), E.A. Veterinary Research Organization (Research Branch).

Duties: To do research on environmental physiology of livestock, and in particular to study some important aspect of the physiological characters which enable cattle to adapt to the climatic or nutritional environments of the pastoral areas of East Africa.

Qualifications required: Candidates must be M.R.C.V.S. or possess an equivalent veterinary qualification, and have had approved post-graduate experience of research on animal physiology, OR must have a good Honours Degree in physiology of a recognized University and at least two years post-graduate training or approved experience of research on animal physiology. Possession of a post-graduate degree would be an advantage.

Appointment: Will be to the Senior Scientific Officer or Scientific Officer scale. A candidate with extensive appropriate research experience would be appointed to the Principal Scientific Officer scale.

Veterinary Research Officer (Virologist), E.A. Veterinary Research Organization (Research Branch).

Duties: To do research on East African virus diseases of economic importance to livestock. The V.R.O. (Virologist) will work mainly on rinderpest and rinderpest-like diseases in the foreseeable future. This may include some investigation of wildlife diseases. He may be required to supervise and when necessary take part in the production of rinderpest vaccine.

Qualifications required: Candidates must be M.R.C.V.S. or possess an equivalent veterinary qualification. They should also hold a post-graduate degree or diploma in virology or bacteriology, or have had other approved post-graduate experience of research in virology. Special experience of tissue culture methods would be an advantage.

Appointment: Will be to the Senior Scientific Officer or Scientific Officer scale for officers with veterinary qualifications. A candidate with extensive appropriate research experience would be appointed to the Principal Scientific Officer scale.

Veterinary Research Officer (Bacteriologist), E.A. Veterinary Research Organization.

Salary scale: S.O.: £1,020 x £44-£1,108 x £46-£1,292 per annum.

S.S.O.: £1,338 x £52-£1,598 x £56-£1,766 per annum.

P.S.O.: £1,839 x £75-£2,064 per annum.

Duties: To do research on East African bacterial diseases of economic importance to livestock. The V.R.O. (Bacteriologist) will work solely on contagious bovine pleuro-pneumonia in the foreseeable future, and in particular will do research on the immunology and pathogenesis of the disease with a view to improving present methods of immunization and diagnosis. He may be required to supervise and when necessary take part in the production of bovine pleuro-pneumonia vaccine.

Qualifications required: Candidates must be M.R.C.V.S. or possess an equivalent veterinary qualification. They should also hold a post-graduate degree or diploma in parasitology, or have had other approved post-graduate experience of research in bacteriology. Special experience of research on the Mycoplasmas would be an advantage.

Appointment: Will be to the Senior Scientific Officer or Scientific Officer scale for officers with veterinary qualifications. A candidate with extensive appropriate research experience would be appointed to the Principal Scientific Officer scale.

Veterinary Research Officer (Protozoologist), E.A. Veterinary Research Organization (Research Branch).

Salary scale: S.O.: £1,020 x £44-£1,108 x £46-£1,292 per annum.

S.S.O.: £1,338 x £52-£1,598 x £56-£1,766 per annum.

P.S.O.: £1,839 x £75-£2,064 per annum.

Duties: To do research on East African protozoal diseases of economic importance to the livestock, with primary emphasis on the tick-borne diseases of cattle and in particular East Coast fever. This may include some investigation of wildlife diseases.

They should also hold a post-graduate degree or diploma in parasitology, or have had other approved post-graduate experience of research in protozoology. Experience of research on tick-borne diseases would be an advantage.

Appointment: Will be to the Senior Scientific Officer or Scientific Officer scale for officers with veterinary qualifications. A candidate with extensive appropriate research experience would be appointed to the Principal Scientific Officer scale.

Veterinary Research Officer (Helminthologist), E.A. Veterinary Research Organization (Research Branch).

Duties: To do research on East African helminth diseases of economic importance to livestock, and in particular to study the epidemiology, pathogenesis and pathology of fascioliasis of domestic ruminants.

Qualifications required: Candidates must be M.R.C.V.S. or possess an equivalent veterinary qualification. They should also hold a post-graduate degree or diploma in parasitology, or have had approved post-graduate experience of research in helminthology. Experience of the snail-borne trematode diseases would be an advantage.

Appointment: Will be to the Senior Scientific Officer or Scientific Officer scale for officers with veterinary qualifications.

Scientific Officer, E.A. Institute for Medical Research. (Pensionable).

Applicants must have at least a B.Sc. degree, preferably in zoology or parasitology and post graduate research experience. An interest in research is an essential qualification. The work involves field and laboratory problems of transmission of bilharzia mainly in the Mwanza area but the successful candidate must be prepared to travel all over East Africa. Housing is available.

Air Traffic Control Officer Cadets, E.A. Directorate of Civil Aviation.

The East African Directorate of Civil Aviation offers training for interesting, responsible and well-paid careers in Air Traffic Control, for young African men between the ages of eighteen and twenty-five years, possessing a Cambridge School Certificate with credits in English language, Mathematics, and Physics, or Physics with General Chemistry, or Science.

The training is of three to three and a half years' duration, which will include Meteorology, Telecommunications, Air Traffic Control procedure, Pilot-Training and Navigation and will include "on-the-job" training.

The commencing salary is £268 per annum, and on successful passing of an intermediate examination, £520-£620 p.a. At the end of the training and subject to passing the final examinations the candidate is eligible for promotion to Air Traffic Control Officer in the salary scale of £850-£1,348 p.a. with prospects of £1,390-£1,590.

These posts are pensionable and successful candidates are expected to sign a bond to work for the E.A. Common Services Organization from the date of commencement of training until a minimum period of three years from completion of training has elapsed. Telecommunications Officer, Cadets (Operational), E.A. Directorate of Civil Aviation. (Pensionable).

The E.A. Directorate of Civil Aviation offers training for interesting and well-paid careers in Civil Aviation Telecommunications to young African men not more than twenty-three years old who possess a Cambridge School Certificate with at least a credit in English. A knowledge of French would also be an advantage. The course is of two years' duration followed by one year of practical training and the commencing salary is £268 per annum rising to £520 per annum after one year if the trainee is successful in passing a course examination. At the end of three years, subject to passing a higher examination, the candidate is eligible for promotion to Communications Officer III (£670-£820) and opportunities will exist for advancement to higher positions in the Telecommunications Operational Branch of the Directorate.

These posts are pensionable and successful candidates are expected to sign a bond to work for the East African Common Services Organization from the date of commencement of training until a minimum period of three years from completion of training has elapsed. On completion of their training successful candidates may be posted for duty anywhere in East Africa. Recruitment, which is limited to an intake of ten trainees, takes place in January.

Telecommunication Engineer, E.A. Directorate of Civil Aviation.

Training is offered in this well-paid and interesting field to young African men not more than twenty-three years old who possess a Cambridge School Certificate with credits at least in Mathematics, English or General Science, Physics or Physics with Chemistry. The course is of three to three and a half years' duration and the commencing salary is £268 per annum rising to £520 per annum after one year if the trainee is successful in passing a technical examination. At the end of the training, subject to passing a higher technical examination, the candidate is eligible for promotion to Assistant Engineer (£850) rising to £1,060. Opportunities will exist for advancement to higher position in the Engineering Branch of the Directorate.

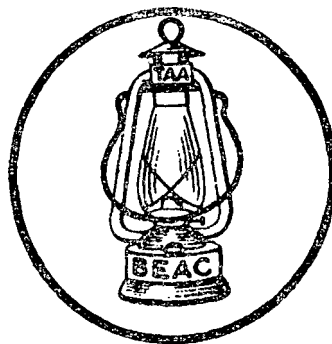
