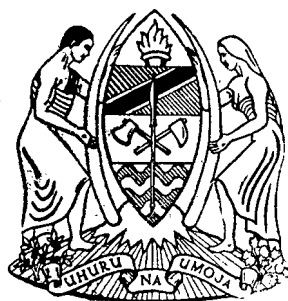

Applicants should be qualified accountants with at least ten years accounting experience in the Administration or other large scale organization, although an unqualified candidate with exceptional accounting experience would be considered. In addition, a House Allowance of £67 per annum is payable to Division I Trainees if Railway accommodation is not provided. Leave will be earned at the rate of twenty-four days per annum. SALE OF STANDING TIMBER BY TENDER

Tenders are invited for an exclusive 5-year licence to fell and extract standing timber from the Longuza Forest Reserve in the E. Usambaras, Tanga Region.

The felling area will comprise 5 annual coupes each of approximately 300 acres from which the annual yield is expected to be 60,000 cu. ft. of obligatory species. In the event of an annual coupe failing to provide 60,000 cu. ft. of timber, permission will be given in any year for felling to continue in the next coupe until the figure of 60,000 cu. ft. has been achieved.

All trees of the following obligatory species having a girth over bark of 5 ft. or more shall be felled:—

Mvule (*chlorophora excelsa*).
 African mahogany (*Khaya nyasica*).
 Antiaris (*Antiaris toxicaria*).
 Mpepete (*Dialium holtzii*).
 Mtumbati Mtoni (*Pterocarpus stolzii*).
 Newtonia (*Newtonia buchananii*).
 Omulera (*Albizia gummifera*).

Logs over 6 ft. in length and having a girth over bark at the smaller end of 2 ft. 6 ins. shall be classed as usable.

Defect rebates will be granted in the proportion of defective timber up to a maximum of 50 per cent of the tendered fee. Logs more than 50 per cent defective need not be taken.

No distance or improvement rebates will be given.

Tenders will be considered on the basis of—

- The fees per cu. ft. tendered for each of the obligatory species;
- the capital available in terms of money and equipment, which an applicant can provide for the efficient working of the licence. Full details must be submitted with the tender;
- written plans, which must be sent with the tender, for promoting African participation in the undertaking and for training of forest labour;
- the part experiences of the applicant in felling, logging and extraction operations.

Applicants will be required to inspect the felling area before submitting tenders, which should include certificates stating that this inspection has been undertaken.

The principal working conditions of the licences will be—

- All trees shall be felled as close to the ground as possible and in the case of unbuttressed trees no stumps shall be higher than 6 ins. In the case of buttressed trees stump height will be determined by the Regional Forest Officer of his representative.
- Felling and cross-cutting shall be done by saw, unless, the use of an axe, which will normally only be used to secure felling direction, is considered justifiable by the Regional Forest Officer or his representative.
- The licensee will be required to construct access and extraction roads; and any culverts and bridges, which may be necessary, adequate to take a loaded vehicle of at least 5 tons. All road alignments must be approved by the Regional Forest Officer before construction begins.
- Ground skidding of logs to loading dumps will be permitted within coupes, but ground skidding will not be allowed along across access and extraction roads. Loading dumps will not be located on extraction roads.
- Permission to log during wet weather will be at the discretion of the Regional Forest Officer.
- The licensee will be required to maintain to the satisfaction of the Regional Forest Officer, all Forest Division roads, bridges and culverts, which are used by the licensee in the course of his operations.
- A bank guarantee for an amount to be determined by the Director of Forestry will be required to be deposited before felling commences.
- Fees on produce taken will be due for payment within 30 days of the presentation of the bill. Failure to pay the fees within the prescribed period will lead to the suspension of the licence. If payment is deferred for more than 60 days after the presentation of the bill the licence may be cancelled.

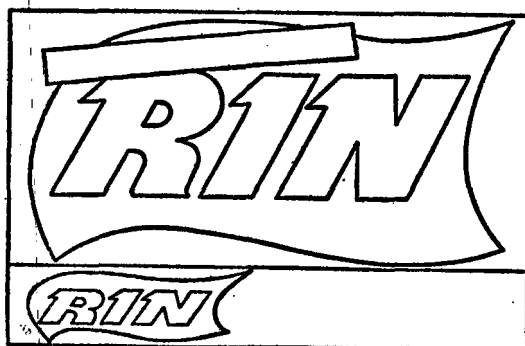
