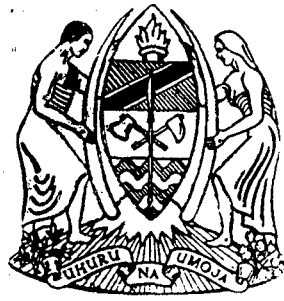

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NATIONAL UNION OF TANGANYIKA WORKERS AND MESSRS. KURASINI DHOW WHARF LABOUR POOL LTD. NEGOTIATED BEFORE MRS. F. NGAHYOMA, LABOUR OFFICER, APPOINTED BY THE LABOUR COMMISSIONER UNDER SECTION 3 (2) OF THE ACT

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

We, the accredited representatives of NUTA hereinafter referred to as the "Union" and Messrs. Kurasini Dhow Wharf Labour Pool Ltd., hereinafter referred to as the "Employer", being parties to a trade dispute reported to the Labour Commissioner, on the 1st September, 1966, and having agreed on 16th December, 1966 on the terms as set out below in respect of certain of the issues reported as being dispute now in witness thereof have appended our signatures hereto.

ISSUE No. 1

Wages: We, hereby agree that the following wages increase shall be paid to all employees:—

- (a) Those employees getting Shs. 175/- up to Shs. 225/- p.m. shall get an increase of Shs. 15/-.
- (b) Those employees getting from Shs. 226/- and over p.m. shall get an increase of Shs. 20/-.
- (c) The employees working at Dhow Wharf shall do 3 tons per man per day and over three tons bonus of Shs. 3/- per extra ton shall be paid to an employee.
- (d) The increase of wages shall be paid from 1st September, 1966.

ISSUE No. 2

Breakfast: It is agreed that breakfast shall be provided to all employees while travelling on duty.

ISSUE No. 3

Relish allowance: It is agreed that Shs. 6/- per day shall be paid to a group of 13 employees as relish allowance when travelling on duty.

ISSUE No. 4

Food allowance: It is agreed that the question of food allowance for employees working at the Dhow Wharf be included in the working hours.

ISSUE No. 5

Probation period: It is agreed that upon engagement an employee shall be on probation period for only one month i.e. 30 days, the period to be calculated from the actual date on which he commenced work. After the probation period an employee shall be employed on permanent terms of conditions of employment.

ISSUE No. 6

Medical care and sick leave: It is agreed that during period of absence due to illness wages at full rate shall be paid for a period of 90 days, provided that the employee shall produce a certificate giving the details of the illness signed by a qualified Medical Officer. Thereafter the rate of half wages shall be paid up to the period of other 90 days and thereafter it will be on the discretion of the employer.

ISSUE No. 7

Working hours: It is agreed that the working hours shall be 40 hours per week and shall be as follows:—

Monday to Friday 7 hours per day i.e. 7.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 3.30 p.m. Saturdays 7.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon.

ISSUE No. 8

Overtime: It is agreed that overtime shall be paid to all employees working in excess of the normal 40 hours in a week, and overtime shall be paid at the rate of one and half (1½) hours worked in excess of the normal hours and when overtime has been worked on Sunday and Public Holidays shall be paid at the rate of double time.

ISSUE No. 9

Annual leave: It is agreed that employees shall be entitled to 21 days paid leave on completion of each 12 months service. Also they will be entitled to Shs. 18/- leave allowance.

ISSUE No. 10

Special leave on urgent private affairs: It is agreed that paid leave on urgent private affairs of employees shall be at the discretion of the employer.

ISSUE No. 11

Tools and machineries: It is agreed that tools and machineries including all other equipments shall be provided by employers for the use of workers.

ISSUE No. 12

Off-loading cargo from schooners to shore: It is agreed that off-loading of cargo which have been loaded on top of hatches (deck) shall be off-loaded by schooners crews (baharias).

ISSUE No. 13

Uniforms: It is agreed that the issue of uniforms is withdrawn.

ISSUE No. 14

Effective date: It is agreed that the effective date shall be the 1st December, 1966.

DURATION OF AGREEMENT

This agreement shall remain in force for the period from 1st December, 1966 to 30th November, 1967, after which either party may for the intention to review this agreement give 30 days notice to that effect.

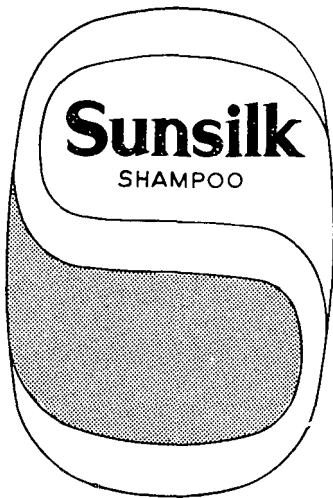

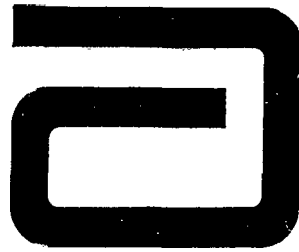

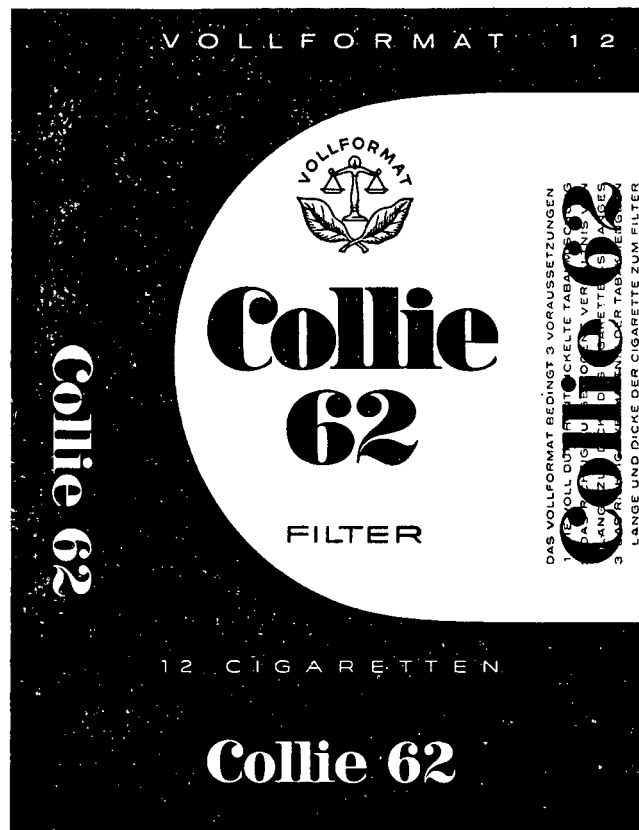
