## STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

2012 No. 7.

### **The Labour Unions (Registration) Regulations, 2012.**

*(Under section 58 of the Labour Unions Act, 2006, Act No. 7 of 2006)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for labour by section 58 of the Labour Unions Act, 2006, Act No. 7 of 2006, these Regulations are made this 28th day of April, 2011.

#### PART I—PRELIMINARY

**1. Title.**

These Regulations may be cited as the Labour Unions (Registration) Regulations, 2012.

**2. Interpretation.**

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Act” means the Labour Unions Act, 2006, Act No.7 of 2006;

“court” means the Industrial Court established under section 7 of the Labour Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) Act, 2006;

“industry” means an economic activity carried out by an enterprise;

“registered organization” means a federation of labour unions as the registrar may certify in the Gazette or a labour union which is registered under the Act; and

“Registrar” means a person appointed by the Minister under section 13 to act as registrar of labour unions and includes any person appointed to be or to act as an assistant Registrar of labour unions.

#### PART II—REGISTRATION

**3. Application for registration.**

An application for registration of a labour union shall be made to the Registrar in Form LU-1 prescribed in the First Schedule and the application shall contain—

- (a) particulars of the members making the application namely, the number, nationality, occupation and address of the members;
- (b) particulars of the labour union namely; the name, physical and postal address of the labour union;
- (c) particulars of the officers of the labour union namely, the name, title, nationality, age, address;
- (d) the occupation of the members; and
- (e) the date of engagement in the industry.

**4. Register.**

The Registrar shall keep a register of all registered labour unions and federations of labour unions in Form LU-2 prescribed in the Second Schedule.

**5. Requirements for registration.**

An application for registration shall be accompanied by—

- (a) three certified copies of the constitution of the labour union;
- (b) the rules of the labour union seeking registration, if any;
- (c) the name of the labour union reserved by the Registrar of companies;
- (d) a certificate of inspection prescribed in Form LU-3 in the Third Schedule issued by the Registrar; and
- (e) a statement of the following particulars—
  - (i) the physical and postal address, telephone contact, e-mail and fax number of the head office;
  - (ii) the number of members;
  - (iii) the title, name, age, address and occupation of each officer;
  - (iv) the name and address of each officer's employer; and

- 
- (v) evidence of payment of the amount of fees prescribed by the Minister.

**6. Certificate of registration.**

(1) Upon fulfillment of the requirements in regulation 5 and subject to sections 17 and 19 of the Act, the Registrar shall issue a certificate of registration to the labour union in Form LU-4 prescribed in the Fourth Schedule.

(2) Upon registration the Registrar shall file returns of the registered labour union with the Registrar of Companies.

**7. Refusal to register a labour union.**

Where the organisation seeking application for registration as a labour union contravenes sections 17 and 19 of the Act, the Registrar shall refuse to register the organisation as a labour union stating the grounds of refusal in Form LU-5 prescribed in the Fifth Schedule.

**8. Formation and registration of a federation of labour unions.**

(1) An application to register a federation of labour unions shall be accompanied by the following—

- (a) the name of the proposed federation reserved by the Registrar of companies;
- (b) the physical and postal address, telephone contacts, e-mail and fax number of the organisation's head office;
- (c) the names of labour unions which have resolved to join the Federation;
- (d) certified copies of the resolutions made by the labour unions;
- (e) the title, name, age, address and occupation of the officers of the organisation;
- (f) the name and address of each officer's labour union;
- (g) the evidence of payment of the amount prescribed by the Minister; and

...with specific rules governing  
...and meetings of the federation.

(2) A resolution made by a labour union for purposes of forming or affiliating to a federation shall be registered with the Registrar.

(3) The provisions of these regulations regarding the registration and cancellation of registration of a labour union and appeal against any decision of the Registrar shall apply to a federation of labour unions.

(4) A change of affiliation by a labour union to another federation of labour unions shall be by way of a Memorandum of Understanding between that labour union and the federation of labour unions.

#### **9. Filing of documents with the Registrar.**

(1) A labour union or federation of labour unions shall file the following documents with the Registrar—

- (a) the rules and constitution of the labour union or federation;
- (b) a statement of account;
- (c) resolutions;
- (d) memorandum of understanding, if any; and
- (e) any other returns required under the Act.

(2) A document filed with the Registrar shall be of the following specifications—

- (a) printed, typed or lithographed in the English language;
- (b) printed on one side of a paper and the size shall be approximately thirty-three centimeters by twenty-two centimeters, with a margin of not less than six centimeters.

#### **10. Register of members.**

(1) A registered organisation shall keep a register of its members in Form LU-6 prescribed in the Sixth Schedule in which shall be entered—

- (a) the name, nationality, address and occupation of every member;



- (b) the date on which each member was admitted;
- (c) the payments made by each member in respect of entrance fees, subscriptions or any other matter, and the dates of such payments; and
- (d) the date on which a person ceases to be a member.

(2) Where a registered organisation or a labour union fails to keep a register of its members in accordance with this regulation, the Registrar shall serve on the union a notice of cancellation of certificate of registration.

## **11. Cancellation of the Certificate of Registration.**

(1) The Registrar shall, before cancelling a certificate of registration issue a two months notice of intention to cancel a certificate of registration under section 20 of the Act.

(2) The notice of intention to cancel a certificate of registration shall be in Form LU-7 prescribed in the Seventh Schedule.

(3) Upon the expiry of the two months notice, the Registrar may confirm the cancellation of registration in Form LU-8 prescribed in the Eighth Schedule.

(4) The order of cancellation of registration shall be published in a newspaper of national circulation or in the Gazette.

## **12. Appeals.**

(1) A notice of appeal against the decision of the registrar shall be in Form LU-9 prescribed in the Ninth Schedule.

(2) The Labour union appealing against the cancellation of certificate of registration shall lodge the notice of appeal with the Registrar of Industrial Court within 30 days after the cancellation and shall send a copy to the Registrar of labour unions.

(3) Upon receiving a notice of appeal, the Registrar of labour unions shall send copies of the inquiries, investigations, any proceedings and reasons for the decision made by him or her to the Industrial Court within fourteen days after receipt of the notice.

**13. Effects of cancellation.**

(1) Upon cancellation of a certificate of registration of a labour union, the trustees of the union shall—

- (a) manage the assets on behalf of the members of the union;
- (b) settle the liabilities of the union; and
- (c) furnish the Registrar with monthly reports on the management of the assets of the union.

(2) The trustees of a labour union whose registration has been cancelled shall upon settlement of all the union's liability dispose of the remaining assets as provided by the constitution of the union.

**14. Access to copies and extracts of documents.**

(1) Copies or extracts from the register of documents in the custody of the Registrar may, upon payment of the prescribed fee, be obtained by any person giving reasonable notice.

(2) A document obtained from the registrar shall be certified as the true copy of the original document in the Registrar's custody.

**15. Replacement of certificate of registration.**

(1) Where a certificate of registration lawfully issued under the Act is shown to the satisfaction of the Registrar to have been lost or destroyed, the Registrar shall issue a substitute certificate, upon payment of a prescribed fee.

(2) The Registrar shall before issuing a substitute certificate require the following—

- (a) a police report;
- (b) a copy of the notice in a newspaper of national circulation informing the general public about the loss or destruction; and
- (c) a statutory declaration stating the circumstances of the loss or destruction.

(3) Where a substitute certificate of registration is issued, the lost or destroyed copy shall have no effect.

---

**16. Amalgamation of Unions.**

(1) A registered labour union proposing to amalgamate with one or more labour unions in the manner provided by section 36 of the Act shall inform all members concerned and other stakeholders the reasons for the proposed amalgamation and the proposed conditions under which such amalgamation is to take place.

(2) A labour union proposing to amalgamate shall send an original copy of the proposed rules and the Constitution of the amalgamated organisation to the Registrar of labour unions.

(3) The notice to the Registrar specified under section 37 of the Act shall be in Form LU-10 prescribed in the Tenth Schedule.

**17. Change of name of a registered organization.**

(1) A registered organisation or labour union shall not change its name unless notice has been given to the Registrar in writing within thirty days before the change of name.

(2) The notice of change of name shall be in Form LU-11 prescribed in the Eleventh Schedule.

**18. Change of officers and trustees.**

(1) The Secretary General of a registered organization shall notify the Registrar in writing of every change of officers, trustees and their titles within fourteen days after the change.

(2) The notice of change of officers, trustees and their titles shall be in Form LU-12 prescribed in the Twelfth Schedule.

**19. Amendment of constitution or rules.**

(1) A registered organisation or labour union may amend the constitution or rules of the labour union by a resolution passed at a general meeting.

(2) The Secretary General shall give the Registrar a notice of amendment of the constitution or rules within fourteen days after the amendment

(3) The notice of amendment shall be in Form LU-13 prescribed in the Thirteenth Schedule.

**20. Registered office and postal address.**

A registered organization shall provide notification to the Registrar in Form LU-14 prescribed in the Fourteenth Schedule showing the following information—

- (a) the situation of the registered office;
- (b) changes in the postal address; and
- (c) any other relevant changes made.

**21. Annual returns.**

(1) The first day of April in each year shall be prescribed as the date on or before which a registered organisation shall furnish to the Registrar the annual returns required under section 50 of the Act.

(2) The annual returns shall be in Form LU-15 as prescribed in the Fifteenth Schedule.

**22. Additional Information.**

(1) In addition to the annual returns specified in regulation 21, a registered organization or labour union shall furnish the Registrar with the particulars of its officers and executive committee as at 31st December of the preceding year, in Form LU-16 prescribed in the Sixteenth Schedule.

(2) The returns shall be accompanied by—

- (a) any alterations of the rules or new rules not already notified; and
- (b) a copy of the union's final account as at 31st December of the preceding year.

**23. Inspection of books of account.**

(1) The Registrar or auditor shall inspect the books of account of a registered organisation at least once a year.

(2) An employer shall have a list of certified auditors from whom an auditor can be appointed to inspect books of accounts of a registered organisation.

**24. General fees.**

The Minister, in consultation with the Labour Advisory Board shall determine fees payable to the Registrar in respect of the matters specified in the Seventeenth Schedule.

**25. Offences and penalty.**

A person who commits an offence under these regulations or contravenes any provision of these regulations is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding ninety six currency points or imprisonment for a term not exceeding four years or both.

**26. Revocation.**

The Trade Unions Regulations, S.I.223-1 are revoked.

(2) The Secretary General shall give the Registrar a notice of amendment of the constitution or rules within fourteen days after the amendment

(3) The notice of amendment shall be in Form LU-13 prescribed in the Thirteenth Schedule.

**20. Registered office and postal address.**

A registered organization shall provide notification to the Registrar in Form LU-14 prescribed in the Fourteenth Schedule showing the following information—

- (a) the situation of the registered office;
- (b) changes in the postal address; and
- (c) any other relevant changes made.

**21. Annual returns.**

(1) The first day of April in each year shall be prescribed as the date on or before which a registered organisation shall furnish to the Registrar the annual returns required under section 50 of the Act.

(2) The annual returns shall be in Form LU-15 as prescribed in the Fifteenth Schedule.

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- (a) any alterations of the rules or new rules not already notified; and
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**25. Offences and penalty.**

A person who commits an offence under these regulations or contravenes any provision of these regulations is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding ninety six currency points or imprisonment for a term not exceeding four years or both.

**26. Revocation.**

The Trade Unions Regulations, S.I.223-1 are revoked.

## **The Labour Disputes (Arbitration And Settlement) (Industrial Court Procedure) Rules, 2012.**

*(Under section 40(1) of the Labour Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) Act 2006, Act No. 8 of 2006).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for labour by section 40(1) of the Labour Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) Act 2006, and in consultation with the Chief Justice, these Rules are made this 28th day of April, 2011.

### **PART I—PRELIMINARY.**

#### **1. Title.**

These Rules may be cited as the Labour Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) (Industrial Court Procedure) Rules, 2012.

#### **2. Interpretation.**

In these Rules unless the context otherwise requires—

“Act” means the Labour Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) Act 2006, Act No. 8 of 2006;

“Court” means the Industrial Court established under section 7 of the Act;

“Registrar” means the Registrar of the Industrial Court appointed under section 12 of the Act.

### **PART II—REFERENCE OF A LABOUR DISPUTE TO THE COURT.**

#### **3. Reference of a labour dispute.**

(1) Where a labour officer is requested by a party to a dispute to refer the dispute to the court under section 5 of the Act, the labour officer shall refer the dispute in the form specified in the First Schedule.

(2) where a labour dispute has been reported to a labour officer and he or she has not referred it to the court or otherwise disposed of it within eight weeks, a party to the dispute may refer the dispute to the court in the form specified in the Second Schedule.

(3) A reference to the court by a labour officer shall be accompanied by—

- (a) a report of the labour officer describing the dispute and the steps taken by him or her to resolve the dispute; and
- (b) all documents and information furnished to the labour officer by the parties.

(4) Where a party to the dispute has referred the dispute to the court the Registrar shall require the labour officer in writing to furnish the court with the information referred to under subrule (3).

#### 4. Receipt of a reference.

Upon receipt of a reference under rule 3 the Registrar shall file and register the reference in a form specified in the Third Schedule and allocate a registration number to the reference.

#### 5. Memorandum of each party.

(1) The Registrar shall, within seven days after registering a reference, give notice to the parties that a dispute has been referred to the court and require each party to file a memorandum and in the case of the claimant, the memorandum shall be filed within seven days after receipt of the notice.

(2) The memorandum referred to in subrule (1) shall set out, in the case of the claimant, the nature and particulars of each item of the claim involved in the dispute and the claimant shall serve a copy of the memorandum on the respondent.

(3) The memorandum under subrule (2) shall be accompanied by an affidavit of service.

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(4) The respondent shall, within seven days after receipt of the memorandum, file a reply as he or she may wish to give to the items of the claim raised in the claimant's memorandum and shall serve the memorandum on the claimant.

(5) The memorandum under subrule (4) shall be accompanied by an affidavit of service.

(6) Each party to the dispute shall submit six copies of the party's memorandum to the court and six copies of such documents as in the opinion of the Registrar may be necessary.

(7) Where the dispute is between an employer and a labour union, the claimant shall attach the recognition and collective bargaining agreement between the employer and the labour union to the memorandum.

#### PART III—HEARING OF A LABOUR DISPUTE.

##### 6. Extension of time.

(1) A party to a dispute who fails to file documents within the prescribed time, may apply to the court for extension of time.

(2) The court may determine the application as it deems fit.

##### 7. Registrar to fix hearing.

(1) The Registrar shall fix a date, place and time of hearing where—

- (a) both parties have filed a memorandum; or
- (b) the time for filing a memorandum has lapsed and no extension of time has been granted by the court.

(2) Where the Registrar has fixed a date for hearing under subrule (1)(b), the parties shall rely on the information and documents submitted to the court.



## **Legal representation.**

In proceedings before the court, a party may appear by himself or herself or by an agent including a labour union or an employer's organisation or may be represented by an advocate.

### **9. Hearing of labour disputes.**

(1) On the hearing date fixed under rule 7, the court shall call upon the claimant to present his or her case including calling any witness that he or she may wish to rely on.

(2) When the claimant closes his or her case, the court shall call upon the respondent to present his or her case and upon closure of the respondent's case, the court shall call upon the claimant to make a reply to the respondent after which the hearing shall be closed.

### **10. Witnesses.**

(1) Where a party wishes to call a witness, the name and address of the witness shall be included in a list of witnesses and it shall be attached to the memorandum submitted under rule 5.

(2) A witness may object to answering a question or to producing a document on the ground that it incriminates him or her.

### **11. Examination and cross examination.**

A party is entitled to examine a witness called by him or her and may cross examine a witness called by the other party.

### **12. Evidence.**

(1) All evidence given to the court at the hearing shall be given on oath or affirmation.

(2) All documentary evidence tendered in the court shall be original or where an original cannot be found, a certified copy of the original.

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PART IV—PROCEDURE OF INDUSTRIAL COURT IN ESSENTIAL SERVICES  
DISPUTES.

**13. Notice of withdrawal of labour.**

(1) Where a notice in writing for a collective withdrawal of labour from an essential service under section 34 of the Act has been given to an employer, the employer shall notify a labour officer of the contemplated withdrawal of labour as soon as practicable.

(2) A labour officer shall notify the Minister in writing of an intended collective withdrawal of labour as soon as practicable but in any case not later than two days from the date he or she is notified.

**14. Reference of collective withdrawal of labour to the court.**

Where the Minister has been notified of an intended collective withdrawal of labour, he or she shall within 5 days after receiving the notice refer the matter to the court in the form specified in the Fourth Schedule.

**15. Filing of reference with Registrar.**

The reference under rule 14 shall be filed with the Registrar and the Registrar shall allocate a registration number to the reference.

**16. Memorandum of each party.**

(1) The Registrar shall within five days after registering a reference require each party to file a memorandum and any further and better particulars.

(2) A claimant shall within five days after being required to file a memorandum, file a memorandum setting out the nature and particulars of each item of the claim involved in the dispute and shall within the five days serve the memorandum on the respondent.

(3) A memorandum filed under subrule (2) shall be accompanied by an affidavit of service.

(4) The respondent shall within five days after being served with a memorandum under subrule (2), file a reply as he or she may wish to the items of the claim raised in the claimant's memorandum.

**17. Setting a hearing date.**

(1) Where both parties have filed their memorandum and further and better particulars, if required to do so, the Registrar shall set a date, time and place for hearing within five days after the date on which the memorandum or further and better particulars were required to be given or agreed to be given.

(2) The Registrar shall in any case fix the date for hearing to be within five days after due service of the memorandum on the respondent where the respondent has not filed a reply to the claimant's memorandum.

(3) In a case to which subrule (2) applies, the hearing shall, unless withdrawn proceed to be determined exparte.

**18. Expeditious hearing.**

(1) The court shall in the case of essential services inquire into and determine a reference expeditiously and shall declare its findings not later than twenty one days from the date of the commencement of the hearing.

(2) The court shall sit from day-today and may, for the purposes of hearing and determining the reference—

- (a) suspend any other matter pending before it; and
- (b) sit during Sundays and on public holidays where it considers it necessary for ensuring compliance with subrule (1).

**PART V—DECISIONS AND AWARDS OF THE COURT.**

**19. Decision of the court.**

(1) After hearing the parties, the court shall make a decision based on the evidence adduced before it.

(2) The decision of the court shall be by consensus reached by the members of the court.

(3) Where the court is unable to reach a decision by consensus, the matter shall be decided by the Chief Judge.

**20. Awards of the court.**

(1) An award or decision of the court shall be announced by the Chief Judge in the presence of the parties to the dispute.

(2) An award or decision of the court shall take effect from a date determined by the court but in any case, not earlier than the date the dispute arose.

(3) The court may, when making an award, determine the period during which the award shall remain in force.

**21. Awards to be submitted to the Minister.**

The Registrar of the court shall submit to the Minister, a copy of every award of the court.

**22. Enforcement of awards or decisions of the court.**

(1) An award or a decision of the court shall be enforceable in the same way as a decision in a civil matter in the High Court.

(2) A party to an award or decision of the court who fails or refuses to abide by the terms of the award or decision of the court shall be held liable for contempt of court.

**PART VI—APPEALS.**

**23. Appeals from decisions of the court.**

(1) Where a party is dissatisfied with a decision of the court, he or she may appeal to the Court of Appeal.

(2) An appeal shall lie from a decision of the court to the Court of Appeal only on a point of law, or to determine whether the court had jurisdiction over the matter.

(3) Appeals under this rule shall be made under the Judicature (Court of Appeal) Rules, S.I. No.13-10.

**24. Appeals from decisions of a labour officer**

(1) A party who is dissatisfied with a decision of a labour officer on a complaint made under section 13 of the Employment Act 2006, or sections 4 and 5 of the Act may appeal to the court.

(2) An appeal under subrule (1) shall lie on a question of law, and with leave of the court, on a question of fact forming part of the decision of the labour officer.

(3) The court may confirm, modify or reverse any decision from which an appeal is made.

(4) In hearing an appeal, the court shall follow the procedure for hearing disputes provided for under these Rules.

(5) The appeal shall be made in the form specified in the Fifth Schedule.

**PART VII—MISCELLANEOUS.**

**25. Revocation of S.I. 224 - 3**

The Trade Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) (Industrial Court) (Procedure) Rules S.I. 224 - 3 are revoked.

**The Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) Order, 2012.**

*(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, Cap. 361).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, Cap. 361, this Order is made this 3rd day of February, 2012.

**1. Title.**

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) Order, 2012.

**2. Temporary maximum speed limit.**

A temporary maximum speed limit is prescribed up to a limit of 180km per hour for drivers of motor vehicles, who compete in the Mbarara Motor Club (MMC) Rally to be held on 24th - 26th February, 2012.

**3. Exemption.**

Subject to paragraph 2, a person who drives a motor vehicle and competes in the Mbarara Motor Club (MMC) Rally to be held on the 24th - 26th February, 2012, in the districts of Masaka, Rwengo, Lyantonde, Mbarara, Sheema and Bushenyi, organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Club of Uganda (FMU), in conjunction with the Southern Motor Club (SMC), is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, S.I No. 33 of 2004 during the rally.
