AMENDMENT OF GENERAL NOTICE NO. 363 OF 2017, POLICY DIRECTION RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF POWER PLANTS TO UTILISE INDEGENOUS OIL RESOURCES

(Under section 17 of the Electricity Act, 1999, Cap. 145)

This Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority under section 17 of the Electricity Act, 1999, Cap 145, this 3rd day of August, 2018.

PREAMBLE

- WHEREAS the Government of Uganda has put in place a plan in the National Oil and Gas Policy for Uganda, 2008 to develop its petroleum resources, the key aspects of which include the development of an oil refinery, the construction of a crude oil export pipeline and the production of oil for power generation;
- WHEREAS the Government strategy in the National Oil and Gas Policy for Uganda 2008 is to use oil and gas resources to contribute to the country's energy mix by promoting the use of some of the crude oil, excess gas and Heavy Fuel Oil (HFO) from the oil refinery activities in the generation of electricity with a view to ensuring adequate and affordable energy supply;
- WHEREAS the Government had a target to produce the first oil by 2018 but due to a number of factors, this target will not be achieved and the revised petroleum production plans in line with the first oil is scheduled for 2020;
- AND WHEREAS the Minister of Energy and Mineral Development issued to the Electricity Regulatory Authority a "Policy Direction relating to the Development of Power Plants to Utilize Indigenous Oil resources" on the 5th May, 2017, under General Notice No. 363 of 2017;
- NOTING that as a result of Government projections, Albatros Energy Uganda Ltd. was licensed under the Electricity Act, 1999, to develop a power plant to utilize indigenous Ugandan Petroleum resources;

POLICY DIRECTION

- NOW THEREFORE, the following Policy Direction amending General Notice No. 363 of 2017 is given to

the Electricity Regulatory Authority (the Authority) to observe and implement—

- The Policy Direction Relating to the Development of Power Plants to Utilize Indigenous Oil Resources issued on the 5th May, 2017 vide Gazette Notice No. 636 of 2017 is hereby amended to allow Albatros Energy Uganda Ltd. to import and use Heavy Fuel Oils to generate 50 Megawatts of electricity until the Refinery project commences operations and ready to supply Heavy Fuel Oils to Albatros or when the licensees under the Petroleum (Exploration, Development and Production) Act, 2013 shall have resolved the technical issues that presently prevent them from committing to supply crude oil or gas to Albatros.
- The Government shall from time to time advise the Authority and Albatros on the prevailing policy to be observed in respect of the development of power plants which shall use indigenous petroleum without any adverse effect to the functions of the Authority.

- NOTING THAT in 2005 through 2008 the country experienced a severe energy crisis caused by the prolonged drought experienced by the country at the time and the country introduced thermal power as a short and medium intervention to ameliorate the energy

- (1) The Policy Direction Issued to all Sector Players in Respect of the Energy Mix of the Country issued on the 12th August, 2017 vide Gazette Notice No. 47 of 2017 is hereby amended to remove the 87 MW Cap on the capacity of energy from wind and solar.
- (2) This Policy Direction shall be reviewed once substantial change in the generation mix is realized and from time to time as may be deemed necessary.
