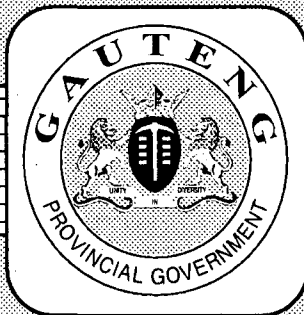

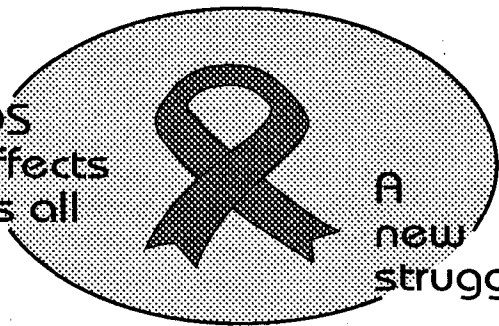

**NOTICE 5403 OF 2001****DEPARTEMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT, ROADS AND WORKS****GAUTENG INTERIM MINIBUS TAXI-TYPE SERVICES ACT, 1997 (ACT NO. 11 OF 1997)****AMENDMENTS TO THE APPLICATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES IN THE AREA OF JURISDICTION OF THE GREATER EAST RAND (EKURHULENI) METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY.**

**I, Khabisi Mosunkutu, Member of the Executive Council for Public Transport, Roads and Works in the Province of Gauteng**, having published regulations in terms of Section 49 (7) of the Act under General Notice No. 5357 in the Provincial Gazette Extraordinary No. 177 dated 04 September 2001, I now make amendments to the aforementioned regulations published on 04 September 2001 as contained in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

1. The following routes and ranks are closed for minibus taxi-type services for a period commencing at **00h01 on Thursday, 06 September 2001 until at 00h01 on Monday, 17 September 2001;**

### 1.1 Routes

- 1.1.1 GE0248 Dunswart to Barcelona** described as follows; Commissioner Street, Princess Avenue, Bunyan Street, Holfontein, Etwatwa, West Barcelona.
- 1.1.2 GE0266 Benoni to Barcelona** described as follows; Hurpur Avenue, Bunyan Street, Puttfontein, Kingsway Road, Umgababa, Barcelona Formal Settlement and Morgan Tebateba Road.
- 1.1.3 GE0253 Twatwa (Lasvegas) to Benoni** described as follows; Etwatwa (Lasvegas), Holfontein, Snake Road, New Modder Road, Amphthil Road, Hurpur Avenue, Voortrekker Street, Kimbilton Street, Reading Road, Mabuya Street, Balayi Street, Masoleng Street, Mamokele Street, Xaba Street and Dube Street; **Alternative** Morgan Tebateba Road, Eislen Road, Heald Street, Modderbee Road, New Modderfontein Road, and back
- 1.1.4 GE0609 Dunswart South and North to Kingsway** described as follows; Sytex Road, Reading Street, Circle Lancaster Road, Rangeview Road, Modderfontein / Puttfontein R51, Kingsway or Lindelani Squatter Camp.
- 1.1.5 GE0610 Kingsway to Dunswart North** described as follows; Modderfontein, Modderbee Road, New Modder Road, Amphthil, Commissioner Road and Dunswart North Taxi Rank.
- 1.1.6 GE0611 Actonville Circle to Kingsway** described as follows; Lancaster, Rangeview, Puttfontein / Modderfontein (R51), Kingsway or Lindelani.
- 1.1.7 GE0612 Apex Industrial to Kingsway** described as follows; Apex Road, Detroit Road, Apex East Street, Modderfontein / Puttfontein Road (R51), Kingsway or Lindelani.
- 1.1.8 GE0613 Barcelona to Rynfield** described as follows; Barcelona, unnamed Street, Durant Road, Mgababa, Kingsway Road, Springs Road, Totius Road, Concord Road, Pretoria Road and Hassie Park.

## 1.2 Ranks

**1.2.1** Las Vegas Taxi Rank – situated in Etwatwa, Extension 9, along Morgan Tebateba Road.

**1.2.2** Benoni Market Blue Rank – situated in Benoni along Hurpur Avenue.

## 1.3 Exclusions

**1.3.1** The following routes and ranks are specifically excluded from the application of these special measures;

**1.3.1.1** N12, Luton Road, Liverpool Road, Birmingham Road, Main Reef Road and Tom Jones Road.

2. No person may undertake minibus taxi-type services on the routes and ranks as specified in regulation 1 during the indicated period. Any person who does so will commit an offence and will be liable for conviction to imprisonment for a period not exceeding **six months** or a fine not exceeding **R10 000**, or **both a fine and imprisonment**.
3. Regulations 1 and 2 may be withdrawn earlier by a notice in the Government Gazette in a case of reports and information received indicating that the security situation of participants in the taxi industry as well as passengers in the above area has been normalized. In this regard reports in respect of the progress to reach the agreement between the various participants in the taxi industry, supported by satisfactory supporting mechanisms to ensure that discipline in the industry can practically be enforced, will be taken into account when the normality/abnormality of the situation and the question whether regulations 1 and 2 are still necessary is assessed by the MEC for Public Transport, Roads and Works (Gauteng Provincial Government) on daily basis.
4. The Gauteng Provincial Permit Board is hereby authorised to issue temporary permits on application of the Chief Director Transportation Management (Gauteng Department of Public Transport, Roads and Works) to operators of motor vehicles with a carrying capacity of more than 16 persons, including the driver, to operate on the closed routes for the period as specified in regulation 1 or a part thereof. These permits will automatically terminate when regulations 1 and 2 are withdrawn.
