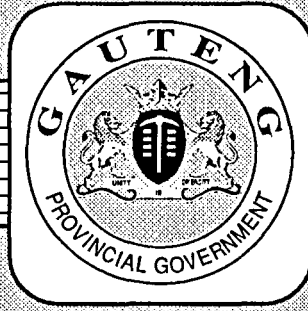

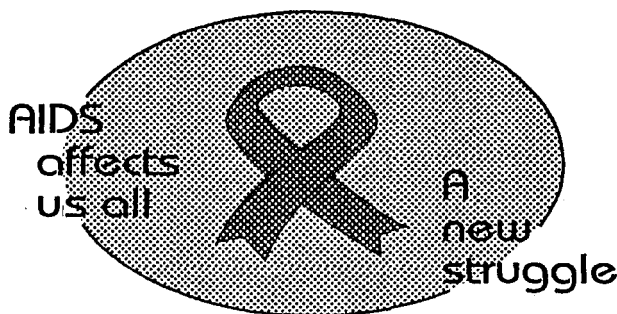

2. Each nomination must be accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae indicating the nominee's knowledge and understanding of examinations and assessment processes in schools and other learning institutions.
3. The composition of the Examinations Board should reflect representivity on the basis of race, gender, inclusivity and equity.
4. Nominations must reach the MEC for Education within 30 of the publication of this Notice.
