VERKLARING VAN ONBEVOEGDHEID INGEVOLGE SUBARTIKEL (3) VAN ARTIKEL TWEE VAN DIE MOTORVOERTUIGASSURANSIEWET, 1942 (WET No. 29 VAN 1942), SOOS GEWYSIG.

DECLARATION OF INCOMPETENCE IN TERMS OF SUB-SECTION (3) OF SECTION TWO OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE ACT, 1942 (ACT No. 29 OF 1942), AS AMENDED.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by subartikel (3) van artikel twee van die Motorvoertuigassuransiewet, 1942 (Wet No. 29 van 1942), soos gewysig, gee ek, BAREND JACOBUS SCHOEMAN, Minister van Vervoer vir die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, hierby kennis dat die British and Overseas Insurance Company, Limited, wie se geregistreerde kantoor geleë is te Standard House, Lower Collingwoodweg, Observatory, Kaapprovinsie, synde 'n geregistreerde maatskappy kragtens die bepalings van genoemde Wet No. 29 van 1942, onbevoeg geraak het om assuransiebesigheid (soos in die toepaslike wetsbepalings op versekering omskryf) in die Republiek van Suid-Afrika te dryf.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section (3) of section two of the Motor Vehicle Insurance Act, 1942 (Act No. 29 of 1942), as amended, I, BAREND JACOBUS SCHOEMAN, Minister of Transport for the Republic of South Africa, hereby give notice that the British and Overseas Insurance Company, Limited, whose registered office is at Standard House, Lower Collingwood Road, Observatory, Cape Province, being a registered company in terms of the said Act No. 29 of 1942, has become incompetent to carry on motor insurance business (as defined in the applicable law relating to insurance) in the Republic of South Africa.
